- Synergies in approaches

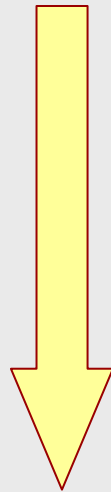

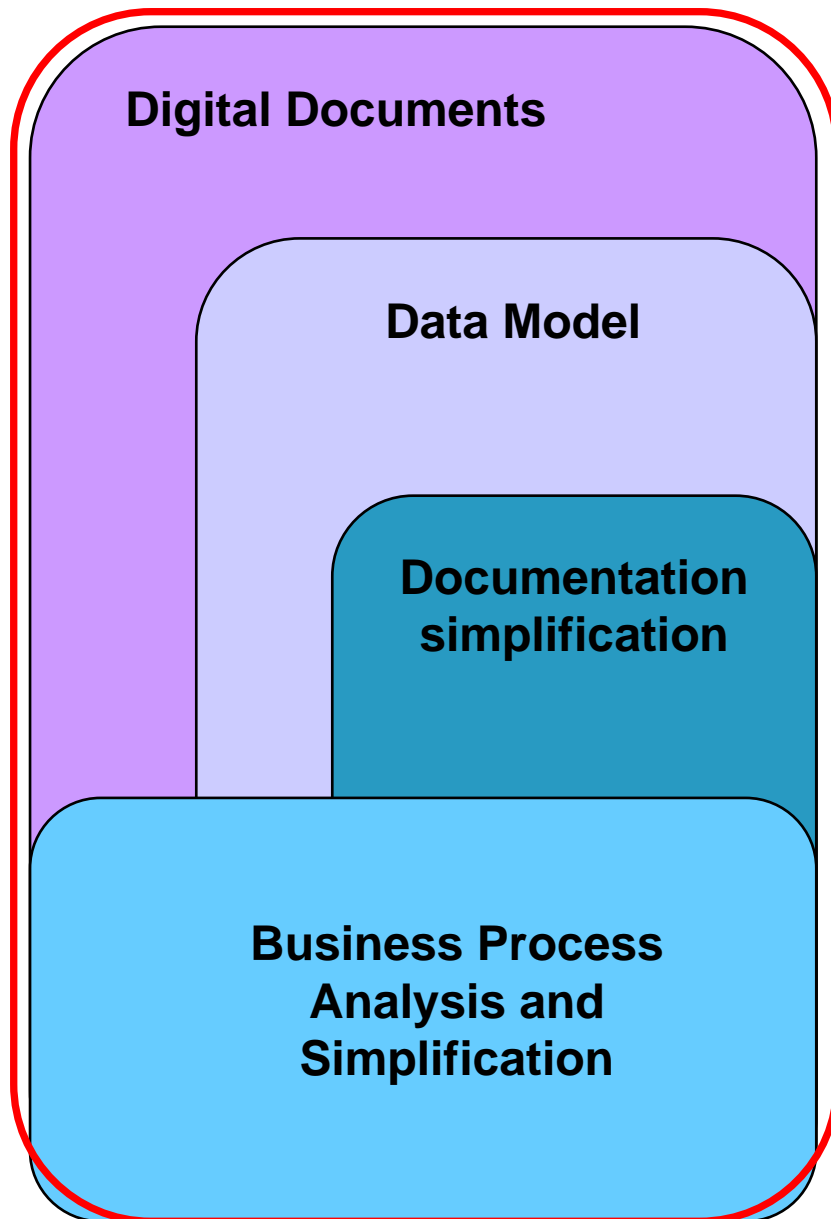


## Automation of data exchange in Single Window

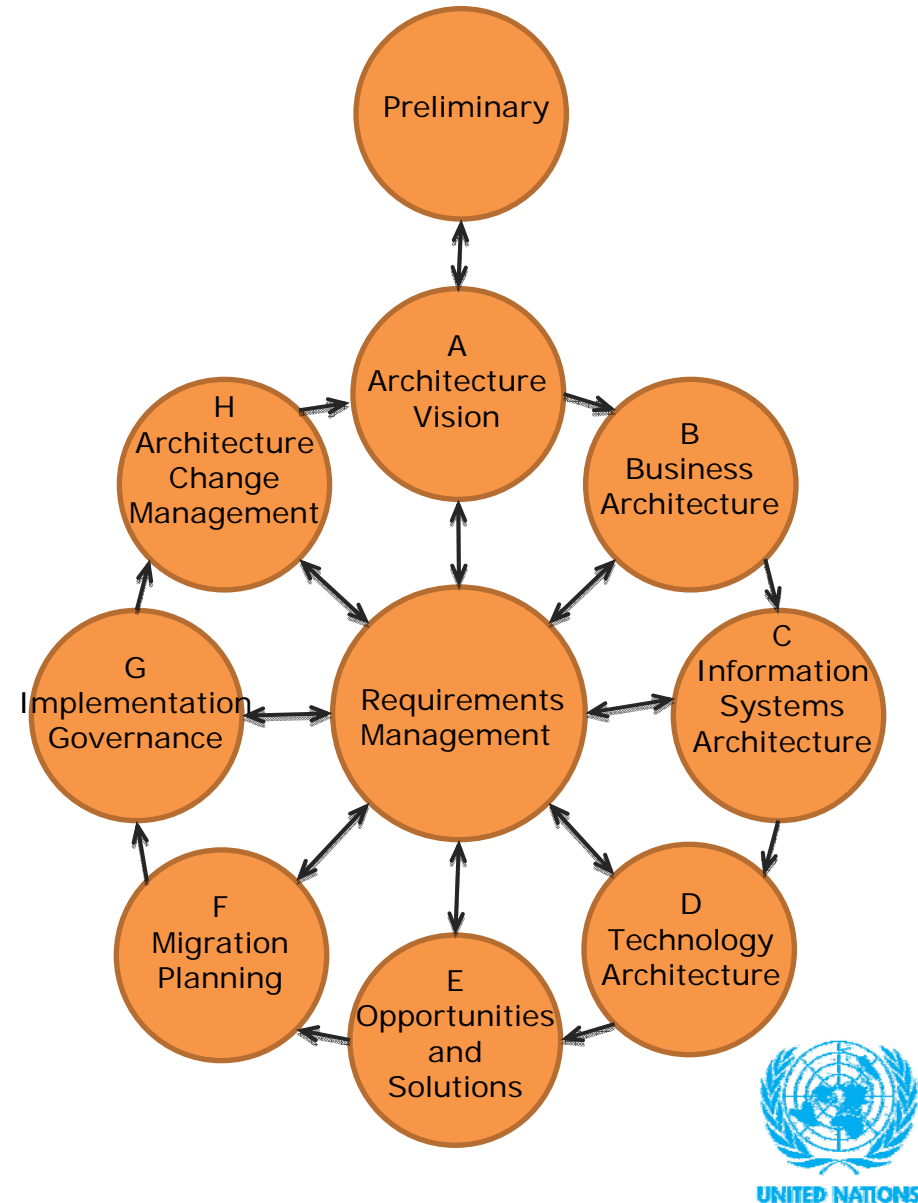
