*During the New Delhi Forum (October 2014) we had a discussion about sustainable agriculture, the Abu Dhabi declaration of UNGC, the importance of farm, location and product identifiers and product coding. Also certification and traceability are important issues in sustainable agriculture.*

*The UNCEFACT agriculture domain has developed several messages schemas which can contribute to the sustainable agriculture, and more messages are in a development stage. And the objects included in the message schemas are / will be included in the Core Component Library.*

*Relevant existing message schemas in sustainable agriculture includes eCERT, eDAPLOS, and eLABs, and under development are Track and trace of animals and fish, the FLUX messages (fish monitoring and reporting), eCROP and eLAB III (harmonising code lists).*

*On Tuesday April 21 the focus will be how the UNCEFACT agriculture projects can cooperate with other initiatives in sustainable agriculture and rural development with partners by example UNGC, ITC, CITES, APEC, UNECE, GlobalGAP and GS1.*
