

**Addendum to the Memorandum of Understanding
between
the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe
and
the Central Mining Institute of Katowice, Poland, PGNiG, PIG-PIB**

Whereas, the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (hereinafter referred to as “**UNECE**”), the Central Mining Institute of Katowice (hereinafter referred to as “**GIG**”, Polish Oil and Gas Company (hereinafter referred to as „**PGNiG**”), Polish Geological Institute – National Research Institute (hereinafter referred to as “**PIG-PIB**”), referring to the acronym of its Polish name Państwowy Instytut Geologiczny – Państwowy Instytut Badawczy), entered into a Memorandum of Understanding dated as of October 30, 2015 (hereinafter referred to as “**MoU**”).

Whereas, Oil and Gas Institute – National Research Institute (hereinafter referred to as “**INiG-PIB**”, referring to the acronym of its Polish name Instytut Nafty i Gazu – Państwowy Instytut Badawczy), as an institution under the Polish Ministry of Energy, is a leading research and development organization in the field of assessment of hydrocarbon resources, exploration prospects for oil and natural gas, exploitation of the resources, including gas from unconventional deposits and coal mine methane, storage, transportation, distribution and use of natural gas, crude oil and petroleum products, the protection of the environment in the oil and gas industry, quality assessment of hydrocarbon fuels and biofuels.

Whereas, pre-mining drainage, capture and use of methane may significantly decrease the total greenhouse gas emission, mitigate climate change, and improve mine safety and productivity.

Whereas, UNECE, GIG, PGNiG and PIG-PIB recognize the benefits of extending their mutual collaboration to the area of pre-mining drainage, capture and use of methane and extending the participants to the MoU on parties concerned with the exploration, appraisal, development and consecutive extraction of coal mine methane.

Whereas, INiG-PIB agree with the goals and provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding.

NOW THEREFORE, UNECE, GIG, PGNiG, PIG-PIB (hereinafter referred to as “the Parties”), represented by the Director of Sustainable Energy Division in the case of UNECE, the Director-General in the case of GIG, the President of the Management Board and the Vice-President of the Management Board in the case of PGNiG, the Director of the Upper Silesian Branch in the case of PIG-PIB and the Deputy Director in the case of INiG-PIB have agreed to make the following additions to the MoU:

Article I
New participants

1.1. Following the mutual agreement of the Parties, INiG-PIB join the present Memorandum of Understanding and accept to be bound by its terms.

Article II
Extension of the collaboration

2.1. All objectives and responsibilities of GIG, PGNiG and PIG-PIB concerning the ICE-CMM shall apply to INiG-PIB as well. GIG, PGNiG, PIG-PIB and INiG-PIB shall agree to the funding principles of the ICE-CMM.

Article III
Extension of the MoU Focal Points and addresses for notices

3.1 The new parties to the present MOU will designate MoU Focal Points, as indicated below, to plan and develop activities under the present MoU and its Annex and ensure its proper implementation:
