**International Workshop on UNFC-2009 – Theory and Practice  
Warsaw, Poland, 21-22 June 2010**

It is our pleasure to invite you to participate in the International Workshop on the United Nations Framework Classification for Fossil Energy and Mineral Reserves and Resources 2009 (UNFC-2009) which will be held in Warsaw, Poland from 21-22 June. The event is being organized by the Polish Geological Institute – National Research Institute (PGI-NRI) and the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) *in cooperation* with the Department of Geology and Geological Concessions of the Polish Ministry of the Environment.

The aim of the Workshop is to build capacity on UNFC-2009, which is a simplified, generic and user-friendly version of UNFC-2004. The practical application of UNFC-2009 to selected deposits in the Polish mining sector will be discussed in detail. Attention will also be given to the efforts of Poland to harmonize its terminology with that of the UNFC. Whilst Poland will be the key focus of the event, there will also be an opportunity to discuss the application of UNFC-2009 in other countries of the region.
