Report from the Coordinating Committee for Geoscience Programmes in East and Southeast Asia (CCOP) on its UNFC-2009 Education and Outreach Activities 2015–2016

1. The Coordinating Committee for Geoscience Programmes in East and Southeast Asia (CCOP) Technical Secretariat (CCOP TS) continued to update its member countries on the latest developments in UNFC (information dissemination). The updating is undertaken via presentations during project-related workshops (oil/gas and CO₂ storage), steering committee and project coordination meetings, and other opportunities where CCOP TS is invited to deliver a presentation.
2. UNFC-2009 was presented at the following regional events in 2015–2016:
 - (a) CCOP-DMF Workshop on Reporting Petroleum Resources, Reserves and CO₂ Injection Projects, 22–23 April 2015, Bangkok
42 participants from Thailand, Cambodia, China, Indonesia, Korea, Lao-PDR, Malaysia, Philippines, Timor-Leste, and Vietnam
 - (b) ASEAN Council on Petroleum (ASCOPE) 80th National Committee (& Associated Committees) Meeting, May 2015, Bangkok
20 participants from ASCOPE members (national oil companies of ASEAN countries)
 - (c) CCOP CO₂ Storage Mapping Program (CCS-M C2W1): Malaysia case study, 2–4 June 2015, Kuala Lumpur
44 participants from Cambodia, China, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Lao-PDR, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, and Malaysia
 - (d) CCOP-KIGAM Unconventional Oil and Gas Project (UC): Launching Seminar, 9 June 2015, Gyeongju City, Korea
100 participants from various Korean agencies and CCOP member countries
 - (e) CCS-M National Coordinators Meeting, 15–16 Feb 2016, Bangkok
14 participants from CCOP member countries.
3. UNFC is also presented at National Coordinators meetings. At these meetings member countries are updated/consulted on EGRC Bureau discussions and matters related to the development of draft guideline on the use of UNFC 2009 for Injection Projects.
