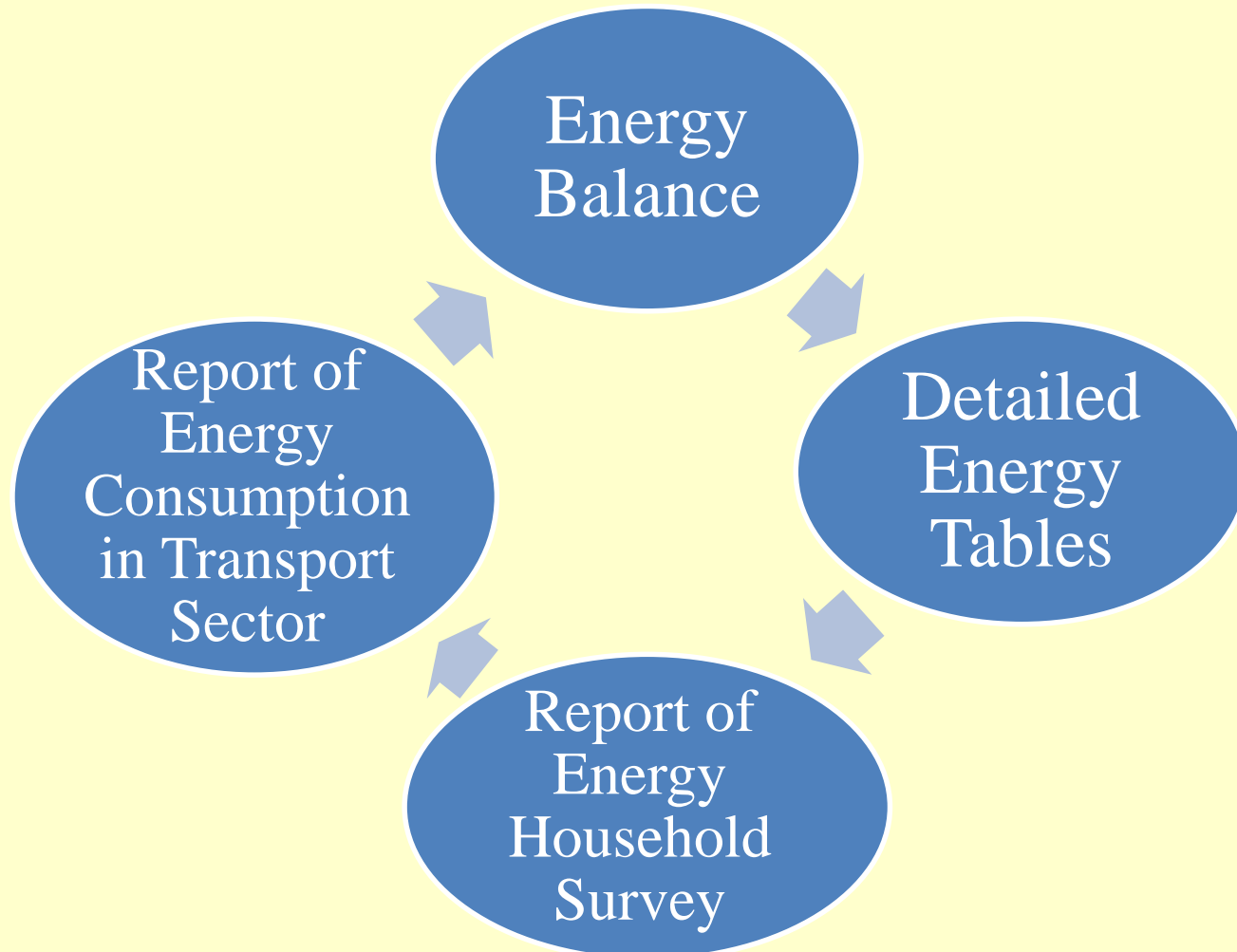


## Introduction

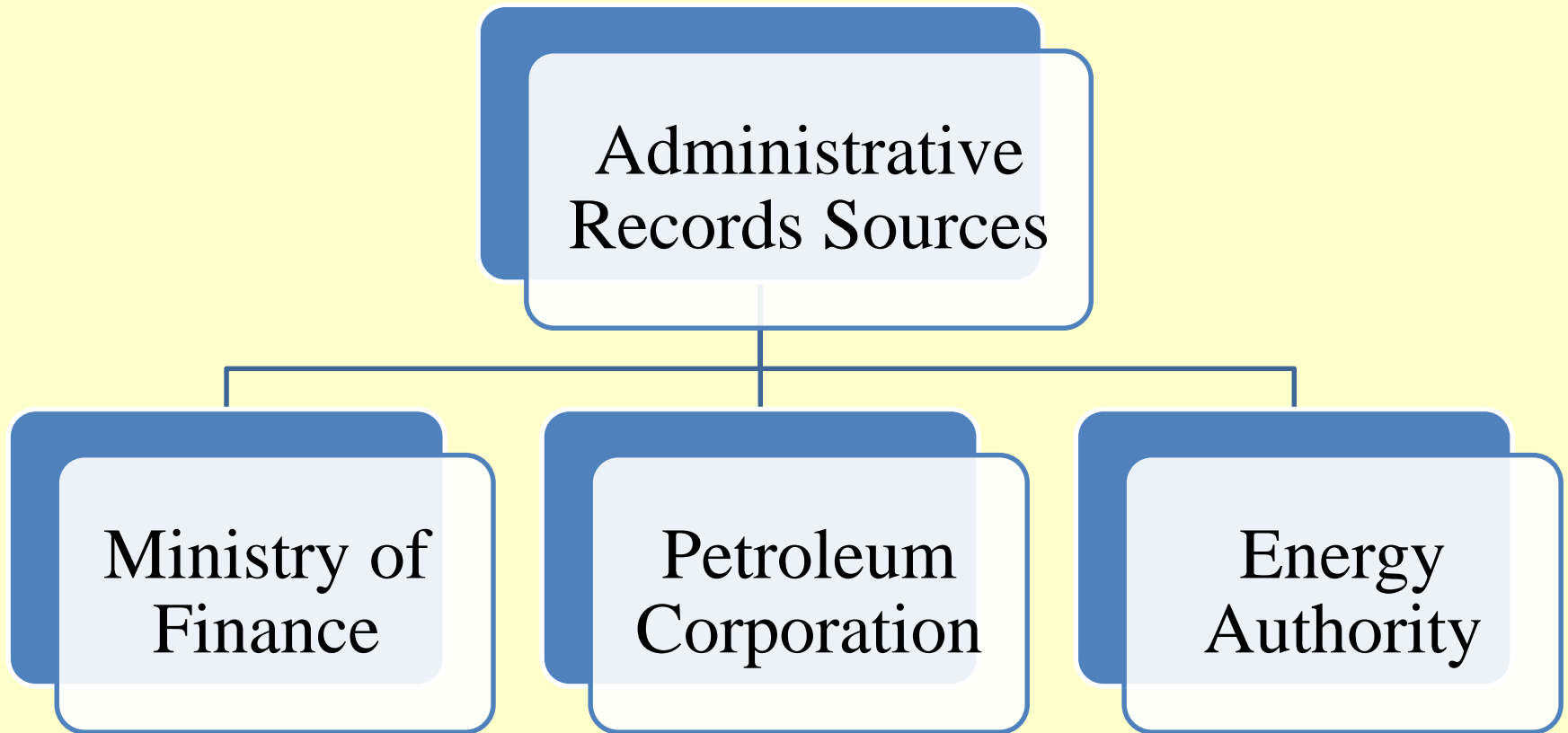

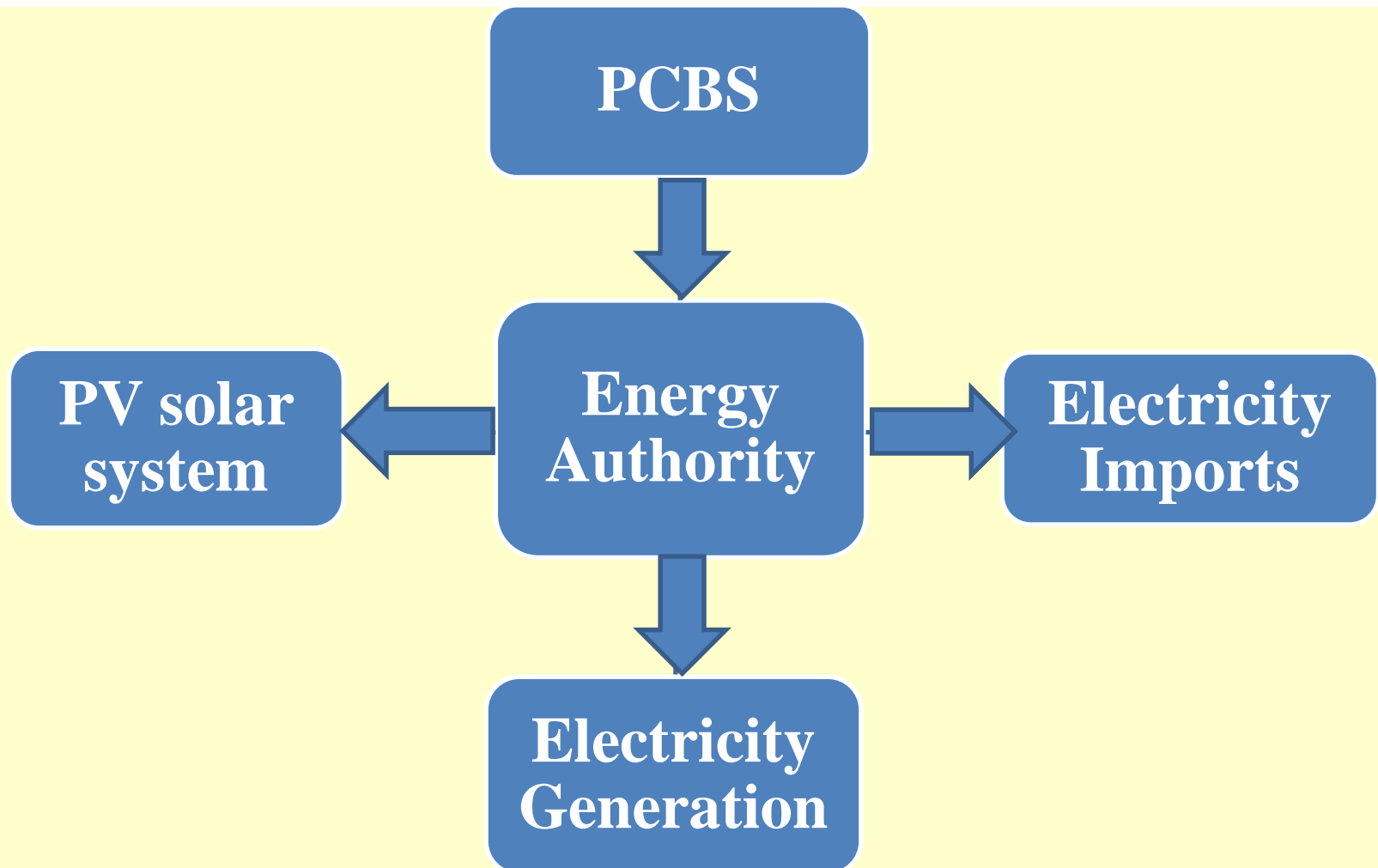

- A survey for energy consumption in the transport sector was carried out, funded by the Islamic Bank and supervised by ESCWA



## Difficulties

- ❖ Data shortage for some sectors such (pumping, government sector,...etc)
- ❖ Delays in receiving the data from the various sources of energy, leading to a delay in publishing data.
- ❖ The Lack of clear boundaries for Palestine, leads to a failure to monitor the quantities that enter through these boundaries.
- ❖ Difficulty in estimating biomass energy.
