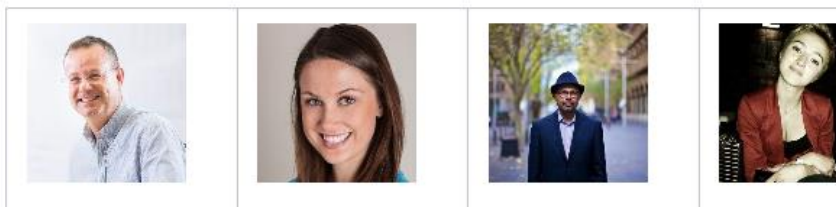

- Once registered, the expert will have an opportunity to edit his/her profile

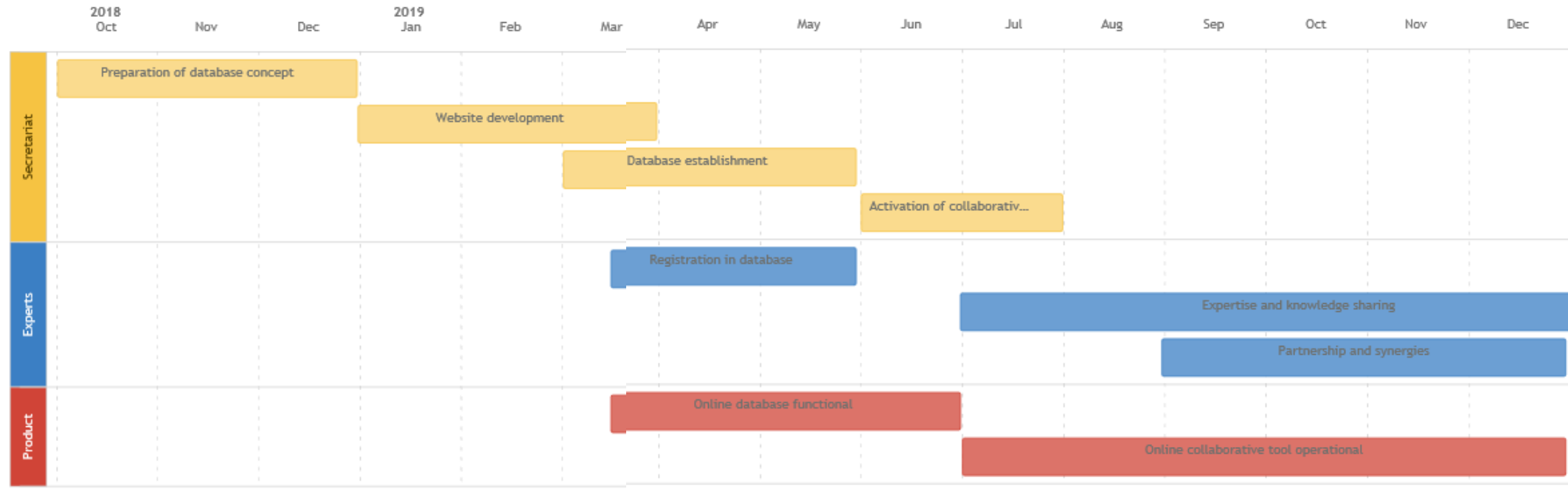
