# Sustainable Energy for All Initiative

## Objectives (by 2030)

- ensuring universal access to modern energy services
- doubling the global rate of improvement in energy efficiency
- doubling the share of renewable energy in the global energy mix





## Group of Experts on Renewable Energy

### Selected activities:

- Review of state of development of renewable energy sources in ECE region
- Action plan for SE4ALL in the ECE Region in collaboration with the other groups of experts and the Committee and start implementation with the help of the private sector, academia, civil society, other international actors
- Best practices, high-impact measures and procedures for an energy transition towards significantly increasing use of renewable energy





# Group of Experts on Cleaner Electricity Production from Fossil Fuels

## Selected activities:

- Assess the efficiency of the existing fleet of conventional power plants in the ECE region
- Deliverables: a baseline analysis of the efficiency of fossil fuel-fired power plants in the UNECE region (presented at the tenth session on 21 October 2014)
