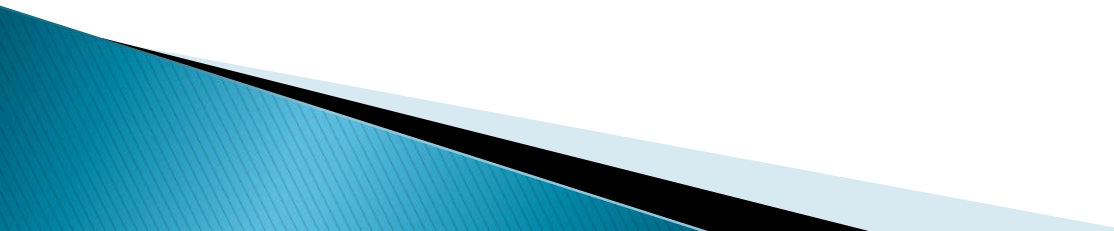


# Application of UNFC–2009 for Reporting

# Opportunities

- ▶ There is an opportunity through existing government structures and stakeholder forums to roll-out and share information on the UNFC-2009
  - ▶ There will be uniformity and consistency in reporting of data by companies using the UNFC-2009 system
- 


# Opportunities

- ▶ Opportunity to improve on reporting and classification system of solid minerals
- ▶ There is an opportunity for government to use UNFC–2009 but, not possible to impose it in mining/exploration companies due to the legal use of SAMREC code in SA

# Challenges

- ▶ Lack of legal backing and inefficient enforcement by government, makes acquisition of data from companies difficult :
  - Companies may disappear with the data
  - Misreporting and underreporting of data
- ▶ Unavailability of computer based GeoData storage system

# Challenges

- ▶ Resistance by companies to provide data and resistance by government to buy in the idea of using the UNFC-2009
  - ▶ Inadequate capacity and awareness to the stakeholders

- ▶ IAEA should send experts to help with the enrolment of the UNFC–2009 in different Member States
  - ▶ Capacity building (training of local committees so that they can be conversant with UNFC–2009)
  - ▶ Implementation of UNFC–2009 backing in policy and legislative framework
