UNFC, Gas Flaring and the World Bank's Global Gas Faring Initiative

The issue:

- 140 bm³ of gas flared from global oil fields in 2011
- 360 million tons of CO₂ released annually
- Annual gas flared in Sub-Saharan Africa alone equivalent to half continent's power consumption
- How can UNFC help?
- SE4ALL High-Impact Opportunity: Phase-out of Gas
 Flaring from Oil Production — about well head values,
 investment and policy

Recommendation

The Expert Group should cooperate with the World Bank Group and the SE4All Global Facilitation Team to explore how UNFC-2009 can contribute to the SE4ALL Goals by facilitating improved energy (resources) management and finance.
