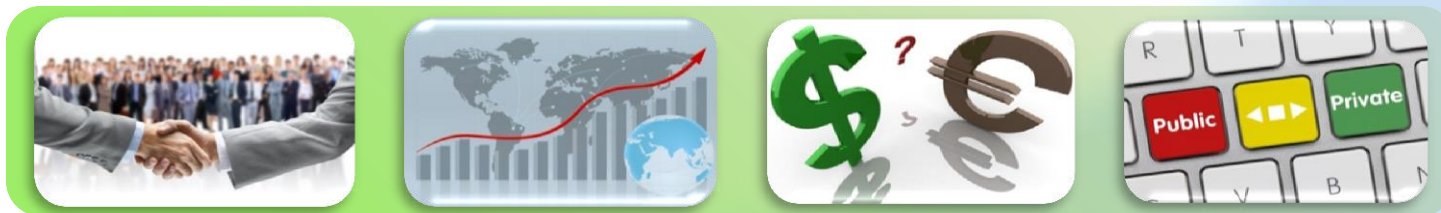
# UNFC delivering on SE4ALL

# UNFC, Gas Flaring and the World Bank's Global Gas Flaring Initiative

## ■ The issue:

- 140  $\text{bm}^3$  of gas flared from global oil fields in 2011
- 360 million tons of  $\text{CO}_2$  released annually
- Annual gas flared in Sub-Saharan Africa alone equivalent to half continent's power consumption

## ■ How can UNFC help?

- **SE4ALL High-Impact Opportunity: Phase-out of Gas Flaring from Oil Production** – about well head values, investment and policy

# Recommendation

**The Expert Group should cooperate with the World Bank Group and the SE4All Global Facilitation Team to explore how UNFC-2009 can contribute to the SE4ALL Goals by facilitating improved energy (resources) management and finance.**
