### Main challenges of ensuring equitable access to water in UKRAINE

■ No physical access:

No WR available

1 000 м³/capita (in dry year <590 м³/сар.)

Long-Term Annual Average Runoff = internal in-flow per capita (Ukr. State Program on WS development by 2020)

80% of Drinking Water supplied from surface water

Water sources polluted

naturally and man-made

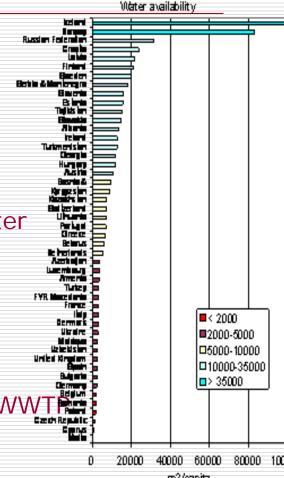
No WSS infrastructure

23% rural settlements have no WS infrastructure

97% rural settlements have no sewer/canalization, WWT

#### Rural WS is a challenge regarding access:

4.6% rural settlements = 951 000 (6.5%) rural residents use water transported by tanks, cisterns



## State targeting program on centralized WS of rural settlements by:

- □ In 2000, the Ukrainian Government adopted a State programme to connect 848 villages from 14 oblasts to a centralized water supply. Centralized solutions were too expensive for the State to build and too expensive for rural communities to operate.
- Only 40 settlements received WS during 2002-2010
- □ In 2010, new policy on rural WS approved. It includes centralized (small water supply systems and "on tap" water treatment measures) + decentralized (shallow wells) solutions. The revised budget allocation is UAH 2.9 billion (about EUR 260 million) for 10 years (2011-2020).



## "Cooperation for rural Sustainable development" + "Safe Sanitation, Health and Dignity"

- Implementation period: 2003 2010
- □ Partners: WECF+ MAMA-86 (9 reg. branches)+ Loc. Authorities +experts
- 6 trainings on ecosan for 22 local trainers Dry toilets and small scale WWTUnits building, composting
- □ 71 DTs funded by project + 10 by HHs DTs + 1 church DT for >800 users were built
- □ 3 rural and 1 town school DTs built for 850 schoolchildren + 60 teachers
- 9 HH and 3 Local WWT units were built
