- ▶ The AWHHE was founded in 1999
- AWHHE staff-epidemiologists, hygienists, etc.
- The first meeting 1999, London, but more have been involved since 2007
- The Protocol requires Public Participation



International level

AWHHE involvement in:

- Task Force on Extreme Weather Events; Guidance on Water and Sanitation in Extreme Weather Events
- Task Force on Target Setting and Reporting
- Working group on Water and Health



International level

- Equitable access to water and sanitation; Scorecard
- Public participation under the WHP; Guidance on Public Participation
- Small scale water supplies



International level

- Information dissemination in International Events such as WWFs, NGO platforms and networks, etc.
- Information is available in the website.



Regional level

- Joint project with UNECE/WECF on public participation:
- 1.Raising awareness activities to increase understanding and awareness on addressing water-related risks
- 2.Regional cooperation: organization of a conference for sharing experiences and contributing to further implementation of the WHP
