## II. Proposed organization of the sessions: overview

1. The Meeting of the Parties to the Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (Espoo Convention) and the Meeting of the Parties to the Convention serving as the Meeting of the Parties to the Protocol on Strategic Environmental Assessment will meet in conjunction in a single meeting room within a sessional period from 2 to 5 June 2014:
  - (a) The Meeting of the Parties to the Convention (MOP), for its sixth session;
  - (b) The Meeting of the Parties to the Convention serving as the Meeting of the Parties to the Protocol (MOP/MOP), for its second session.
2. Delegates will be invited to be present throughout the sessional period.
3. After the opening of the sixth session of the MOP and the second session of the MOP/MOP, the two Meetings of the Parties will be invited to elect their respective chairs for the general segment.
4. The MOP and the MOP/MOP will convene in joint and individual meetings, in sequence, until the high-level segment is convened.
5. The high-level segment will open on the morning of Thursday, 5 June, and continue until 6 p.m. The MOP and the MOP/MOP will convene in joint and individual meetings, in sequence, including for the adoption of decisions and a declaration, as well as for the holding of a panel discussion. Ministers and other heads of delegation will be invited to deliver statements to a joint meeting of the MOP and the MOP/MOP.
6. A side event organized by the Ukrainian non-governmental organization (NGO) Ecoclub, on the application of the Convention to nuclear energy-related activities, is expected to be organized during the lunch break on Tuesday, 3 June.

7. All meeting documentation, the programme of the side events and additional practical information will be made available on the Convention's website.<sup>1</sup>

The provisional agenda was drafted by the secretariat, in agreement with the Bureau, taking into account views expressed by the Parties during the third meeting of the Working Group on Environmental Impact Assessment and Strategic Environmental Assessment (Working Group on EIA and SEA) (Geneva, 11–15 November 2013).

**(d) Report on credentials**

13. According to rule 16 of the rules of procedure of the MOP (ECE/MP.EIA/2, decision I/1), which applies mutatis mutandis to the MOP/MOP, the credentials of representatives of Parties, as well as the names of alternate representatives and advisers, shall be submitted to the secretariat if possible not later than 24 hours after the opening of

the session. Any later change in the composition of the delegation shall also be submitted to the secretariat. The credentials shall be issued either by the Head of State or Government or by the Minister of Foreign Affairs or, in the case of a regional economic integration organization, by the competent authority of that organization. The Bureau will examine the credentials and report on them to the Meeting (see rule 17 of the rules of procedure). Representatives shall be entitled to participate provisionally in the session, pending a decision by the Meeting to accept their credentials (see rule 18). Only Parties with valid credentials will be able to participate in the adoption of a decision or declaration. Parties are also invited to send the secretariat a copy of the credentials two weeks prior to the session.

14. The Meetings of the Parties will be invited to take note of the report by the secretariat on credentials of the representatives of Parties attending MOP-6 and MOP/MOP-2. Representatives may participate provisionally, pending this action.

**(e) Status of the Convention and its amendments and the Protocol**

15. The secretariat will inform participants about the status of ratification of the Convention and the declarations made by Parties upon deposit of their instruments of ratification of the Convention since the fifth session of the Meeting of the Parties (Geneva, 20–23 June 2011). The secretariat will similarly inform the Meetings of the Parties about the status of ratification of the amendments to the Convention adopted at the second and third sessions of the Meeting of the Parties.

16. The secretariat will then report on the status of ratification of the Protocol and the declarations made by Parties upon deposit of their instruments of ratification of the Protocol.

17. Delegations will be invited to report on planned ratifications of the Convention, its amendments and its Protocol.

32. The Chairs for the general segment will invite delegations to nominate a chair and a number of vice-chairs of the Bureau. They will suggest that the Bureau include the Chair and Vice-Chairs of the Working Group. In addition, the general segment Chairs will propose that the chair and the first vice-chair of the Implementation Committee — once elected by the Committee — be members of the Bureau. Further, They will suggest that the chair of the Working Group be a representative of a State or a regional economic integration organization that is a Party to both the Convention and the Protocol.

33. Following each nomination, the Chairs will ask the secretariat to inform the MOP and the MOP/MOP of whether the State nominated is a Party to the Convention or the Protocol. Once sufficient nominations have been made, the Chairs will invite the MOP and the MOP/MOP to consider the endorsement of the nominations in turn. Formal election of the Bureau members will take place in the high-level segment (item 13).

34. The above procedure will be repeated for the new members of the Implementation Committee.

35. The Meetings of the Parties may agree a tentative calendar of meetings of their subsidiary bodies in the intersessional period. Delegations may also wish to put forward proposals for hosting such meetings.

The seminar will illustrate good practice in the application of the Convention and the Protocol to wind energy, and is expected to include also presentations from Slovenia and Ukraine related to hydro energy.

**7. Seminar on the globalization of the Convention and the Protocol and the role of international financial institutions**

*Tentative timing: Wednesday, 4 June, afternoon*

43. A representative of the European Investment Bank (EIB) is invited to chair a seminar that brings together representatives of Governments, NGOs and other stakeholders, mainly from outside the ECE region, as well as from a number of international financial institutions (IFIs). The seminar will provide insights on the practice, needs and expectations of non-ECE countries regarding the implementation of strategic environmental assessment (SEA) and transboundary environmental impact assessment (EIA) procedures, including in view of their possible future accession to the Convention and the Protocol. The seminar will also showcase the experience of IFIs in applying environmental assessments within and beyond the ECE region, including to transboundary energy infrastructure projects.

44. The seminar is then expected to explore means for expanding the awareness and the application of the two ECE treaties for the benefit of other regions, as well as to discuss the role of IFIs in supporting the development of the necessary legislation and institutional capacity for the implementation of the Convention and the Protocol, in particular in countries outside the region.

The Meetings of the Parties will be invited to consider possible follow-up actions under the Convention and the Protocol.

#### **(d) Report on the seminar on the globalization of the Convention and the Protocol and the role of international financial institutions**

50. A representative of EIB will report back to the high-level segment on the outcomes of the seminar on the globalization of the Convention and the Protocol and the role of IFIs (agenda item 7). The Meetings of the Parties will be invited to consider possible follow-up actions under the Convention and the Protocol.

### **9. Panel discussion on the application of the Convention and the Protocol to energy-related issues**

*Tentative timing: Thursday, 5 June, morning*

51. A panel comprising invited ministers and other high-level representatives, as well as experts from Governments and intergovernmental organizations, together with representatives from NGOs and other stakeholders across the ECE region, will present the main achievements, lessons learned and remaining challenges in the application of the Convention and the Protocol in the region, in particular in the energy sector.

52. Delegations will be invited to make short interventions from the floor in response to the presentations.

### **10. Statements by ministers and high-level representatives**

54. Ministers and other heads of delegation, as well as representatives of intergovernmental organizations and NGOs, may make statements, with a recommended time limit of three minutes. The full texts of the official statements will be circulated if a sufficient number of copies are provided to the secretariat in the course of the session. 58. Meeting jointly, the MOP and the MOP/MOP will be invited to consider adoption of the following joint decisions proposed by the Bureau, as reviewed and finalized by delegations during the general segment:
