II. Annotations to the provisional agenda

1. The provisional agenda set out in the present document was prepared by the secretariat to the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (ECE) Convention on the Transboundary Effects of Industrial Accidents (Industrial Accidents Convention) in agreement with the Chair of the Working Group on Development of the Convention (Working Group on Development).

1. Adoption of the agenda

2. The Chair of the Working Group will open the fifth meeting and invite members of the Working Group to adopt the agenda for the meeting, as set out in the present document.¹

2. Workplan and organization of work for 2015–2016

3. The Chair of the Working Group will recall the Working Group's mandate received from the Conference of the Parties at its eighth meeting (Geneva, 3–5 December 2014) and propose a way forward to prepare the requested amendments to the Convention and guidance by the Conference of the Parties based on the proposed organization of work set out in document ECE/CP.TEIA/WG.1/2015/3.

4. The Working Group on Development is expected to discuss and agree on its organization of work for the period up to the ninth meeting of the Conference of the Parties in autumn 2016, including the number of its meetings in the biennium 2015–2016, and the possible support to be provided by a small group of legal experts and another small group of experts on land-use planning.

5. The Working Group is also expected to discuss and adopt its workplan for the period 2015–2016 and the terms of reference for the two expert groups, as contained in the document ECE/CP.TEIA/WG.1/2015/3.

3. Amendment to the Convention

6. At its eighth meeting the Conference of the Parties requested the Working Group to prepare a draft amendment to the Convention relating to articles 1 (definitions), 9 (information to, and participation of the public), 18 (Conference of the Parties) and 29 (ratification, acceptance, approval and accession), considering also related provisions of and annexes to the Convention, for review and adoption at the ninth meeting of the Conference of the Parties. The Working Group was also requested to prepare draft text opening the Convention for accession by Member States of the United Nations beyond the ECE region, as part of the above amendment.

7. The Chair will invite the Working Group to consider draft text for the amendment to the Convention, prepared by the secretariat in cooperation with a legal expert.

8. The Working Group will be expected to discuss the draft text, to provide comments and to agree on the next steps.

4. Accession by Member States of the United Nations from outside the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe region

9. The Conference of the Parties at its eighth meeting requested the Working Group to continue thoroughly considering all aspects related to the opening of the Convention with regard to the potential benefits and challenges, including possible budgetary implications, and to present the outcome of its considerations to the ninth meeting of the Conference of the Parties.

10. The Working Group will be invited to continue its discussions on this issue, based on information provided by the secretariat and contained in official background documents prepared for the eighth meeting of the Conference of the Parties (ECE/CP.TEIA/2014/6) and the twentieth session of the ECE Committee on Environmental Policy (ECE/CEP/2014/6).

5. Guidance by the Conference of the Parties

11. The Conference of the Parties at its eighth meeting decided that guidance on selected provisions of the Convention should be developed by the Convention's subsidiary bodies, for review and adoption at the Conference of the Parties at its ninth or, alternatively, tenth meeting.

(a) Provisions related to land-use planning (art. 7)

12. The Working Group on Development was requested to review a draft guidance document on land-use planning to be drawn up with external expertise. The European Union/European Investment Bank stated at the eighth meeting of the Conference of the Parties that it would act as lead organization for the preparation of this document by a consultant, in cooperation with the secretariats of the Industrial Accidents Convention, the Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context and the Protocol on Strategic Environmental Assessment. Cooperation with the ECE Committee on Housing and Land Management was also envisaged in the implementation of this activity.

13. The secretariat will inform the Working Group about planned activities for the development of the draft guidance document on land-use planning by a consultant, based on a background document prepared by the secretariat (ECE/CP.TEIA/WG.1/2015/5). The Working Group will be invited to take note of the information provided.

(b) Clarifying the scope of mutual assistance (art. 12)

14. The Conference of the Parties also requested the Working Group to prepare a draft decision to clarify the scope of mutual assistance set out in article 12 of the Convention, outlining to what extent mutual assistance referred to any industrial accident or to industrial accidents with transboundary effects only, for review and possible adoption at its ninth meeting.

15. The Working Group will be invited to continue its exchange of views on the scope of mutual assistance and to agree on next steps for the preparation of guidance by the Conference of the Parties. To this end, the Working Group might wish to consider involving the small group of legal experts, proposed to be established by the Working Group.

(c) Provisions on the review of compliance (art. 23)

16. The Conference of the Parties requested the Working Group on Development, in cooperation with the Working Group on Implementation, to consider the introduction of a compliance mechanism and to prepare a possible draft decision for review and possible

adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its ninth meeting, with due regard to the mandate and functioning of the Working Group on Implementation.

17. The Chair of the Working Group on Implementation will provide information on the preliminary discussions held on this matter. The Working Group on Development will be invited to share its views on the introduction of a compliance mechanism and to determine the way forward.
