Preparation Phase

High-level kick-off meeting, Kiev, 11 May 2011

- ▶ Hosted by the Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources of Ukraine
- ▶ High level officials from the Republic of Moldova, Romania and Ukraine
- ▶ The meeting:
 - agreed on project objectives and activities
 - made a detailed presentation of the project implementation plan
 - formally approved the project
 - obtained support to the project from partners

- Technical workshop on hazard management, Chisinau, 12 – 13 July 2011
- Workshop and joint visit to the ports of Galati and Giurgiulesti, 27 – 29 September 2011
- Workshop on safety guidelines for oil terminals and joint visit to the Odessa port, 23 – 25 September 2013
- Hazard and Crisis Management Week, including a table-top exercise and an evaluation workshop addressing complacency (Chisinau, Republic of Moldova, 23 – 26 March 2015)
- Final Workshop of the Project, Bucharest, 20 – 21 October 2015

- ▶ **Draft Joint Contingency Plan for the Danube Delta**


