## Different financing systems for EMEP and WGE

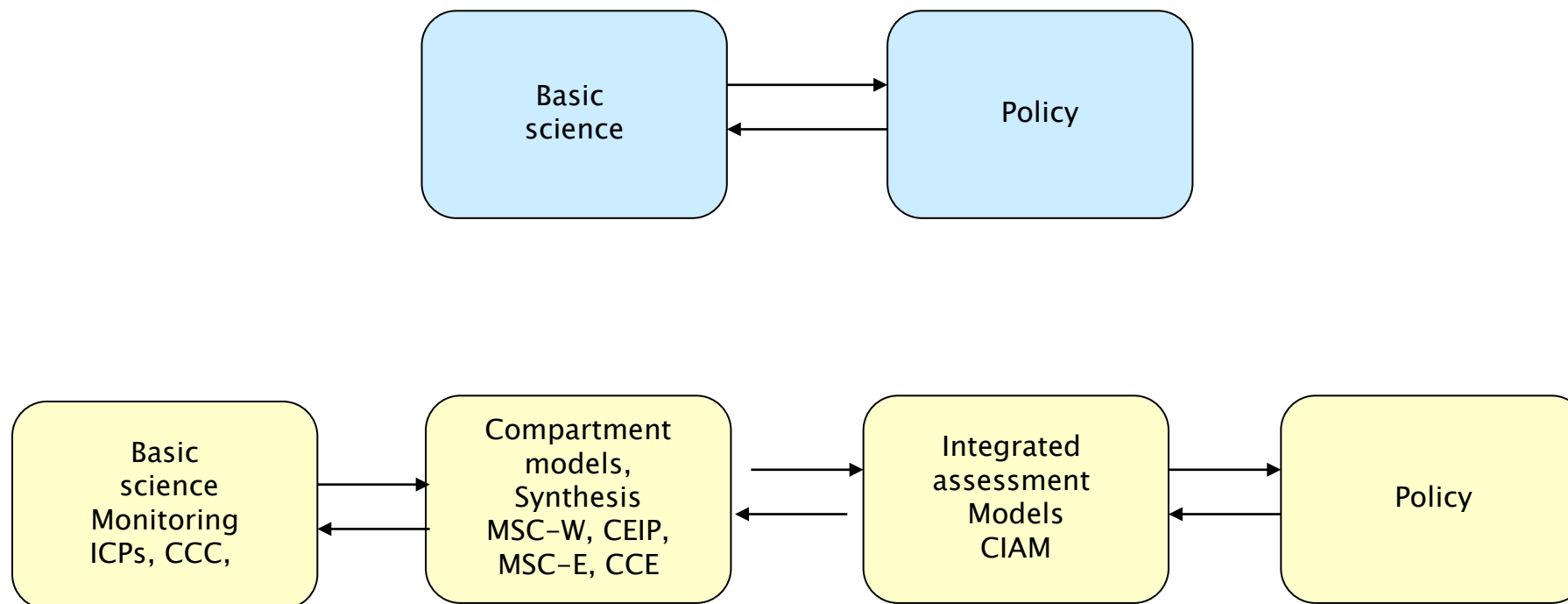
### EMEP

- Five subsidiary bodies (centres)
- Financing regulated through the EMEP Protocol (1984)
- Slow increase in financing

### WGE

- Seven subsidiary bodies (5 ICPs, CCE, TFH)
- Financing regulated through a voluntary trust fund
- Approx. 25% of the budgets covered by the trust fund
- The contribution to the fund is decreasing

## Relations between science and policy for new and mature environmental problems



Coordination Centre for Effects was initiated by the Dutch Government in 1990 and has since then been running with support from the Government.

The CCE is a central body for the Convention and responsible for the development of modelling and geographic mapping methodologies for the assessment of air pollution related effects in Europe.

The CCE is also responsible for collecting and handling of national data on ecosystems and their sensitivities

The CCE supports air pollution abatement policies of the Convention including its parties with scientific information and assessments of environmental impacts under the change of climate and biodiversity in Europe.

## Financing CCE 2017

CCE has during 2016 been running with a reduced budget supported mainly by the Dutch Government and RIVM. The support to CCE from the Government and RIVM will expire 1 January 2017

CCE has presented a reduced budget for 2017 of 203 000 Euro, which was accepted by the second joint meeting of EMEP and WGE.

CCE has also presented an extended budget up to 327000 Euro.

Parties were at the last EMEP/WGE meeting and through direct contacts asked to support CCE to ensure the operation of CCE during 2017

## Confirmed contributions to CCE for 2017

In total Approx 220 k€
