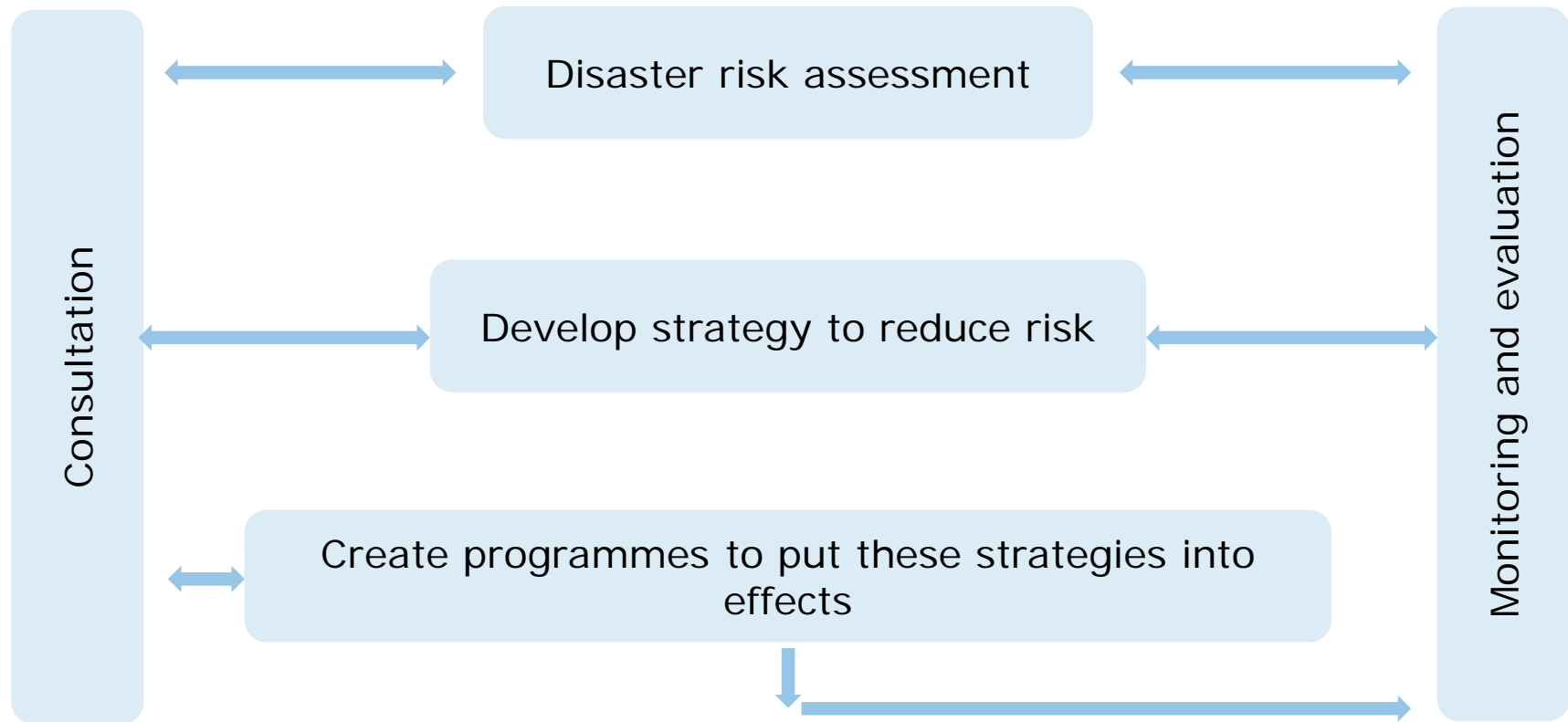
Aims and scope

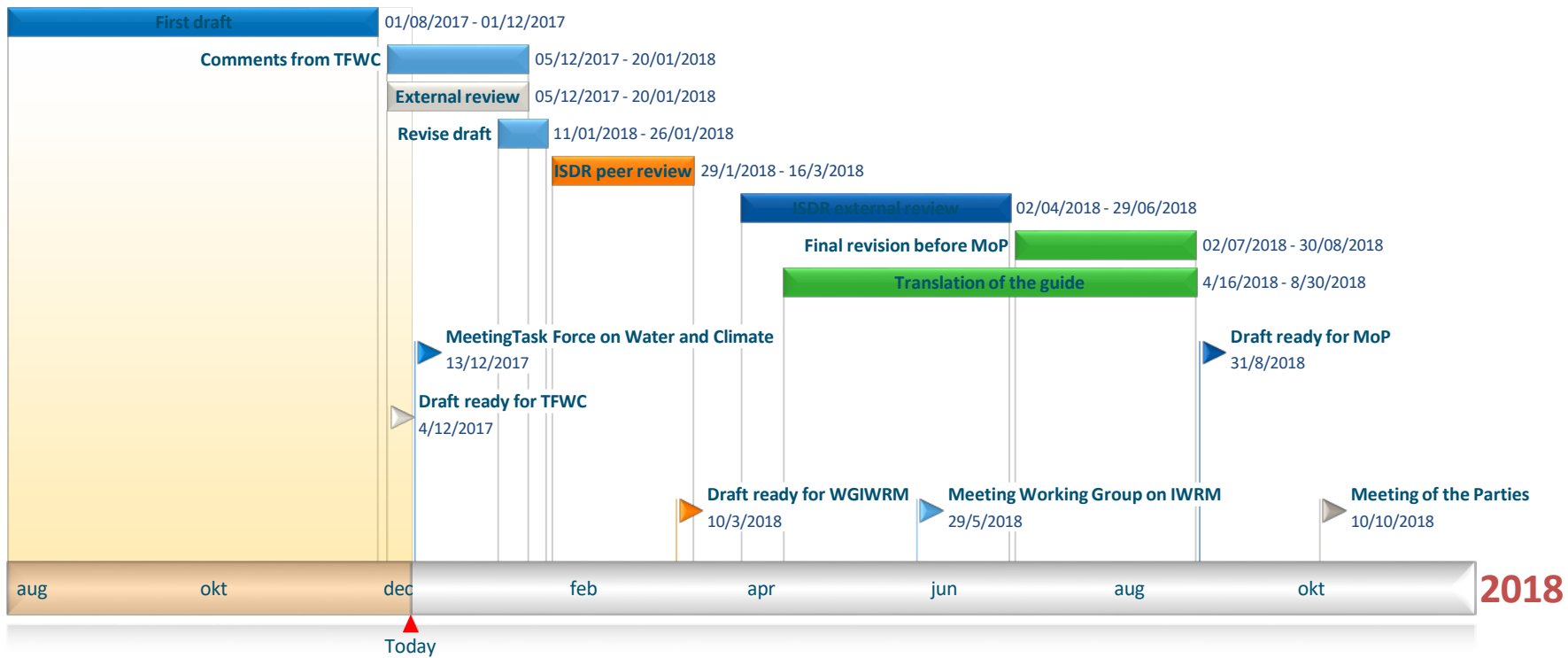
