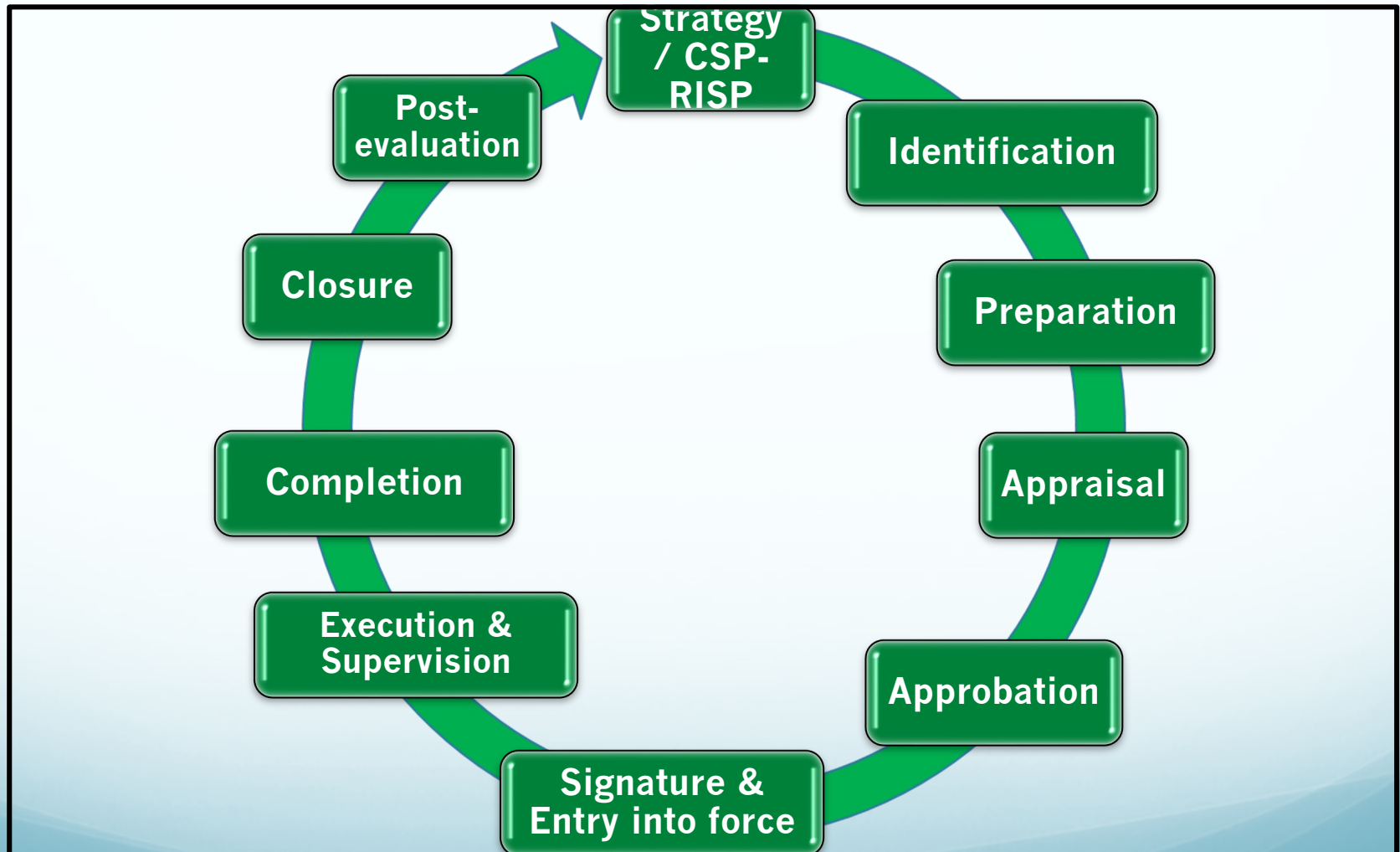
DESIGNING A BANKABLE PROJECT

WHAT IS A PROJECT?

A project is:

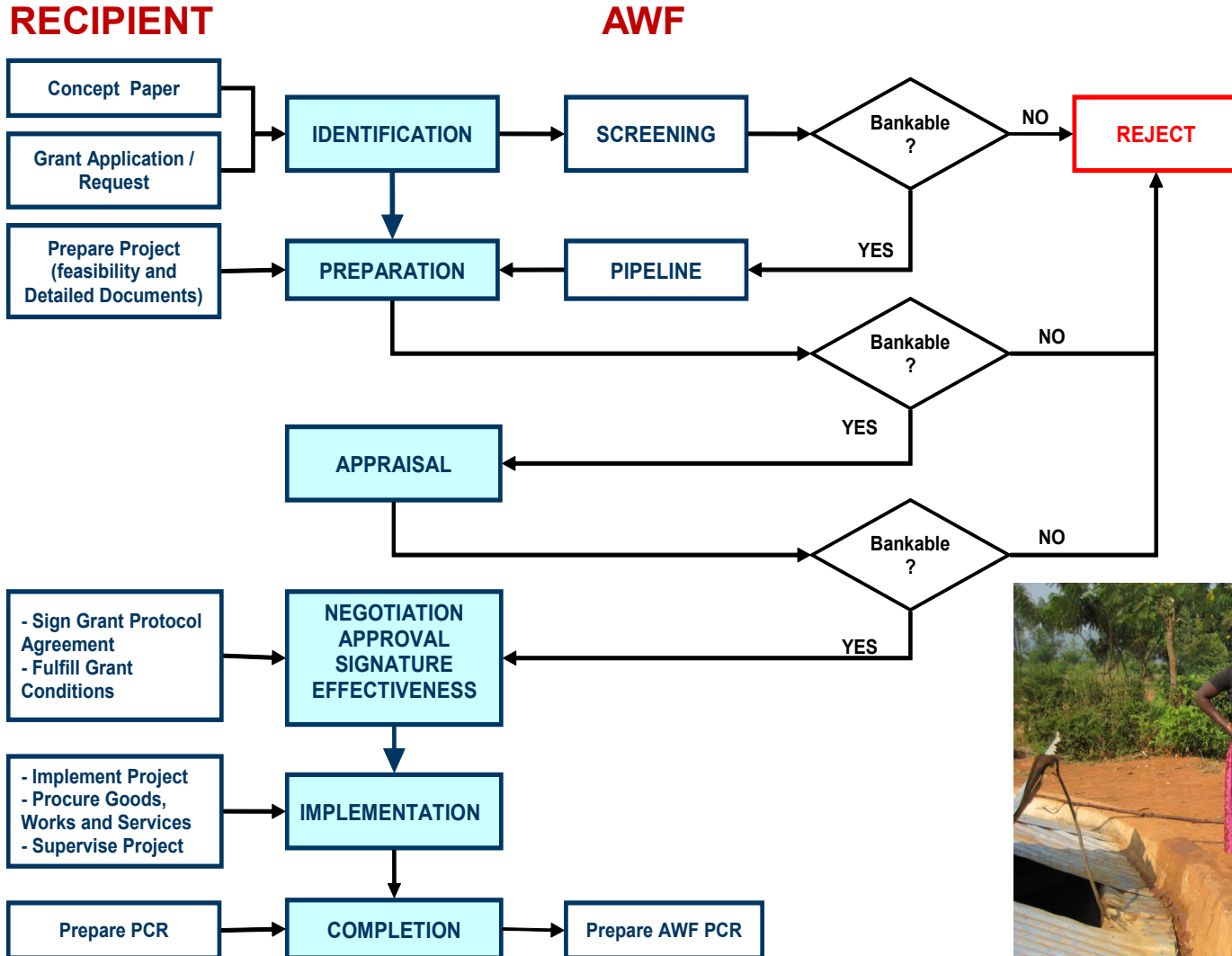
- an objective to be realized,
- by different actors,
- in a precise & complex context,
- within a given deadline,
- with defined means (human, financial, material and immaterial resources).

What does BANKABLE mean?

- Profitable product "that pays money"; and/or
- Investable product that mobilizes resources to finance its implementation.

THE QUESTION IN NOW : HOW TO DESIGN A PROJECT TO BECOME BANKABLE FOR CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION ?

That is exactly the purpose of the workshop

A BANKABLE PROJECT FILLED A MINIMUM OF STANDARDS (international requirements)

- Technical
- Economic & financial
- Environment & climate change issues
- Institutional & legal
- Capacity building
- Appropriation & sustainability
- Risks & mitigation
- Cross-cutting issues (gender, equity, efficiency and effectiveness, Knowledge, etc.)

TO HAVE AN ENABLE ENVIRONMENT FOR THE BANKABILITY OF A TRANSBOUNDARY PROJECT

Existence of a basin organization or a framework for cooperation between the States



TO HAVE AN ORIENTATION AND POLICY DOCUMENT



TO HAVE A STRATEGY AND A STRATEGIC ACTION PLAN



TO HAVE AN OPERATIONAL PLAN OF PRIORITY PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS APPROPRIATED BY THE STATES CONCERNED

GUIDELINES TO MAKE A PROJECT TO BE BANKABLE FOR A FINANCIAL PARTNER

- Identify the donor(s) required for the type of project involved.
- Strictly follow the steps prescribed by the said donor(s).
- Demonstrate the sharing of direct and indirect benefits between the countries concerned.
- Provide evidence of the accession of the countries concerned to the project.
- Especially connect the project to a specific climate change issue in terms of climate finance,
- to be able to connect the dots, between the different local and international requirements (international Agreements, Conventions, Treaties, Directives and approaches),
