


Ambient Air Quality Directives

Maximum concentrations of air polluting substances (PM₁₀, PM_{2.5}, SO₂, NO₂, CO, O₃ + 6 more)

National Emission Ceilings Directive

National emission totals (SO₂, NO_x, VOC, PM_{2.5}, NH₃)












EU-28 reduction targets btw. 2005 and 2030








Reduction commitments (set targets)

Projections (identify compliance gaps)

NAPCP (identify policies / measures)



Source-specific performance standards: examples

Industrial Emission Directive, Industrial Emissions Performance Standards, Ecodesign and Eco-Label standards, BATs and BREFs, ...

Medium Combustion Plants Directive addresses installations at 1-50 MW, setting fuel-specific emission limit values (focus on SO_2 , NO_x and PM), ...

Road transport legislation including type approval standards, ensure real driving emission Euro 6 standards, ...

Non-road mobile machinery legislation e.g. type approval standards, fuel quality standards, Sulphur Directive, NRMM Directive, ...



Roles and responsibilities

- Minimum levels and common requirements at EU level
- Implementation and more detailed legal framework at national level can choose to be more ambitious than the EU limits
- Implementation and further detailed actions and measures at local level
- Cooperation and alignment with work at international level (notably: Air Convention)

The Ambient Air Quality Directives

- Directive 2008/50/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 May 2008 on <u>ambient air quality and cleaner air for Europe</u>, as amended by Commission Directive (EU) 2015/1480
- Directive 2004/107/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 15
 December 2004 relating to <u>arsenic</u>, <u>cadmium</u>, <u>mercury</u>, <u>nickel and polycyclic</u> <u>aromatic hydrocarbons in ambient air</u>, as amended by Regulation (EC) 219/2009 and Commission Directive (EU) 2015/1480
- Commission Implementing Decision 2011/850/EU of 12 December 2011 laying down rules for Directives 2004/107/EC and 2008/50/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the <u>reciprocal exchange of information</u> and reporting on ambient air quality ('the IPR Decision')



The National Emission Ceilings Directive

- Directive (EU) 2016/2284 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 14
 December 2016 on the reduction of national emissions of certain atmospheric pollutants, amending Directive 2003/35/EC and repealing Directive 2001/81/EC
- Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2018/1522 of 11 October 2018 laying down a <u>common format for national air pollution control programmes</u> under Directive (EU) 2016/2284
- Communication 2019/C 92/01 from the Commission Commission Notice on ecosystem monitoring under Article 9 and Annex V of Directive (EU) 2016/2284
- Member States are obliged to annually report their <u>national emission</u> <u>inventories</u>, based on the <u>EMEP/EEA Emission Inventory Guidebook</u>.





The Sulphur Directive

- **Directive (EU) 2016/802** of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 May 2016 relating to a <u>reduction in the sulphur content of certain liquid fuels</u>
- Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2015/253 of 16 February 2015 laying down the <u>rules concerning the sampling and reporting</u> under Council Directive 1999/32/EC as regards the sulphur content of marine fuels
- Close links with the IMO and the International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships (MARPOL)



The Industrial Emissions Directive

- **Directive 2010/75/EU** of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 November 2010 on industrial emissions (integrated pollution prevention and control)
- Directive (EU) 2015/2193 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25
 November 2015 on the <u>limitation of emissions of certain pollutants into the air from medium combustion plants</u>
- European Parliament and Council Directive 94/63/EC of 20 December 1994 on the control of volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions resulting from the storage of petrol and its distribution from terminals to service stations
- Directive 2009/126/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 October 2009 on <u>Stage II petrol vapour recovery during refuelling of motor vehicles</u> at service stations
- Regulation (EC) No 166/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18
 January 2006 concerning the <u>establishment of a European Pollutant Release and Transfer Register</u>
