Progress and activities in 2018-2019

With the EUWI + support, the following actions have been taken:

1. Amendments to the Water Law (Law no. 272) were adopted by the Parliament.
2. New mid-term Action Plan for the Water Supply and Sanitation Strategy has been drafted, the revision of the National Programme to implement the Protocol on Water and Health 2016-2025 is ongoing. New standards for small scale water supply systems adopted.
3. The Republic of Moldova submitted reports on under the Water Convention/SDG indicator 6.5.2 and under the Protocol on Water and Health under the 4th reporting cycle.
4. RBMP (cycle I 2018-2023) was adopted.
5. Support in organizing and conducting the National Policy Dialogue on IWRM in the Republic of Moldova (next meeting in Chisinau on 25 October 2019)
6. Support in improving water monitoring (new laboratory equipment for reference laboratory, expeditions, support in lab reaccreditation, re-delineation of WBs for the Prut RB with Romanian experts)

Lessons learned and challenges

- The Environmental Agency was created
- The reform of the Water Agency of the Republic of Moldova, the elaboration of the new regulation will take into account the management of water resources in accordance with the the basin principle
- The initiation discussions with different governmental institutions regarding the creation of the water fund.

Planned future activities in this area in 2019-2021

- Developing with support of EUWI+ cycle II of RBMP for the Danube-Prut and Black Sea River District (2021-2027).
- Development of a master plan for water supply and sanitation in the Nirnova river basin, including a pilot scheme for local government for the implementation of the Urban Waste Water Treatment Directive (UWWT)
- Finalization and integration of the Code of Good Agricultural Practice (COGAP) in the national regulations for the implementation of the Nitrates Directive
- Adoption of the Action Plan to Water Supply and Sanitation Strategy
- Adoption of the revised National Programme to Implement the Protocol on Water and Health and finalization of the measure on equitable access
