4. Suggested future work in this area

1. Scaling up adoption of water and sanitation safety plans:

- Support uptake of WSPs and SSPs in national policies and legislation and supporting development of country road maps towards long-term scaling up of these approaches
- Capacity building on WSP and SSP approaches in policy and practice on basis of WHO guidelines, including on WSP auditing (in coordination with programme areas 2, 4 and 7)
- Development and implementation of pilot projects on integrated water and sanitation safety plans (in coordination with programme area 4)



4. Suggested future work in this area

2. Focus policy attention and technical efforts on sanitation:

- Dissemination and communication of the findings of the scoping study on sanitation
- Support sanitation policy development at country level
- Development of further policy and/or technical guidance and practical tools in support of sanitation management

3. Climate resilience

- Building climate resilience of drinking water supply and sanitation services, including through climate resilient WSPs and SSPs (in coordination with programme areas 4 and 7)
