

# Priorities for Steering Group

## 1. Content and links to conference

- Deciding on the scope, focus and outline of the EEAOA report (e.g. focusing on major national and macro-regional state of environment reports and thematic assessments from e.g. conventions) and clarifying its role in underpinning the two conference themes.

## 2. Method of Work

- Launching the “Call for evidence” on the basis of the scope decided involving national focal points (whereby countries and relevant bodies will be asked to identify assessments to be assessed).
- Decide on the main analytical criteria for assessing the assessments
- Setting up the relevant Expert Groups and networking with relevant organisations and institutions to carry out the analysis of the proposed assessments according to agreed criteria.

## 3. Resources & plan of work

- Reviewing the plan of work, budget and status of resources.

## 4. Follow up process

- Decide and plan follow-up meetings.
