

Assistance Programme


For countries of Eastern Europe, Caucasus and Central Asia and South Eastern Europe to help them in strengthening the implementation of the Convention and through it industrial safety





Step approach of the Assistance Programme

How to strengthen the implementation of the Convention?







Step 1

Country needs to understand through relevant analysis if it has in place necessary enforcement mechanisms (include: legislation, standards, institutions) for the main areas of work

Support to the country

Indicators & criteria on:

- -Identification of haz. act.
- -Notification of haz, act.
- -Prevention
- -Preparedness
- -Response and mutual assistance
- -Public participation









Step 2

Country identifies the priority for strengthening the implementation and takes the necessary action (National Action Plans)










Step 3



Assistance in Step 2

Projects to address/overcome identified challenge/challenges:

Examples of past projects:

- Project to build understanding on safety reports (Croatia, Serbia, Macedonia):
 - Training session on evaluation of safety reports with a use of checklist methodology
 - Training for inspectors in carrying out safety inspections
- National training session on identification of hazardous activities (Moldova, Macedonia, Azerbaijan)



Assistance in Step 2

- Project to improve crisis management on transboundary rivers between Bulgaria, Romania and Serbia:
 - Workshop to understand each other procedures
 - Joint in-field exercise, including operator of petroleum storage to test effectiveness in response and level of joint response
 - Workshop to discuss the lessons learned

Examples of current projects:

- 1. Project to further improve hazard and crisis management in the Danube Delta (Moldova, Romania and Ukraine)
- National training session on identification of hazardous activities (Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan)
