The workshop is organised by the Ministry of Environment and Natural Resources Protection of Georgia in the framework of two projects: "Development of Legislation for Waste Management as part of the EU-Georgia Association Agreement", funded by the EU Delegation to Georgia and implemented by the ParticipGmbH, and "Greening Economies in the European Neighbourhood (EaP GREEN)" programme, financed by the European Commission, UN Economic Commission for Europe (ECE), OECD, UNEP, and UNIDO.
