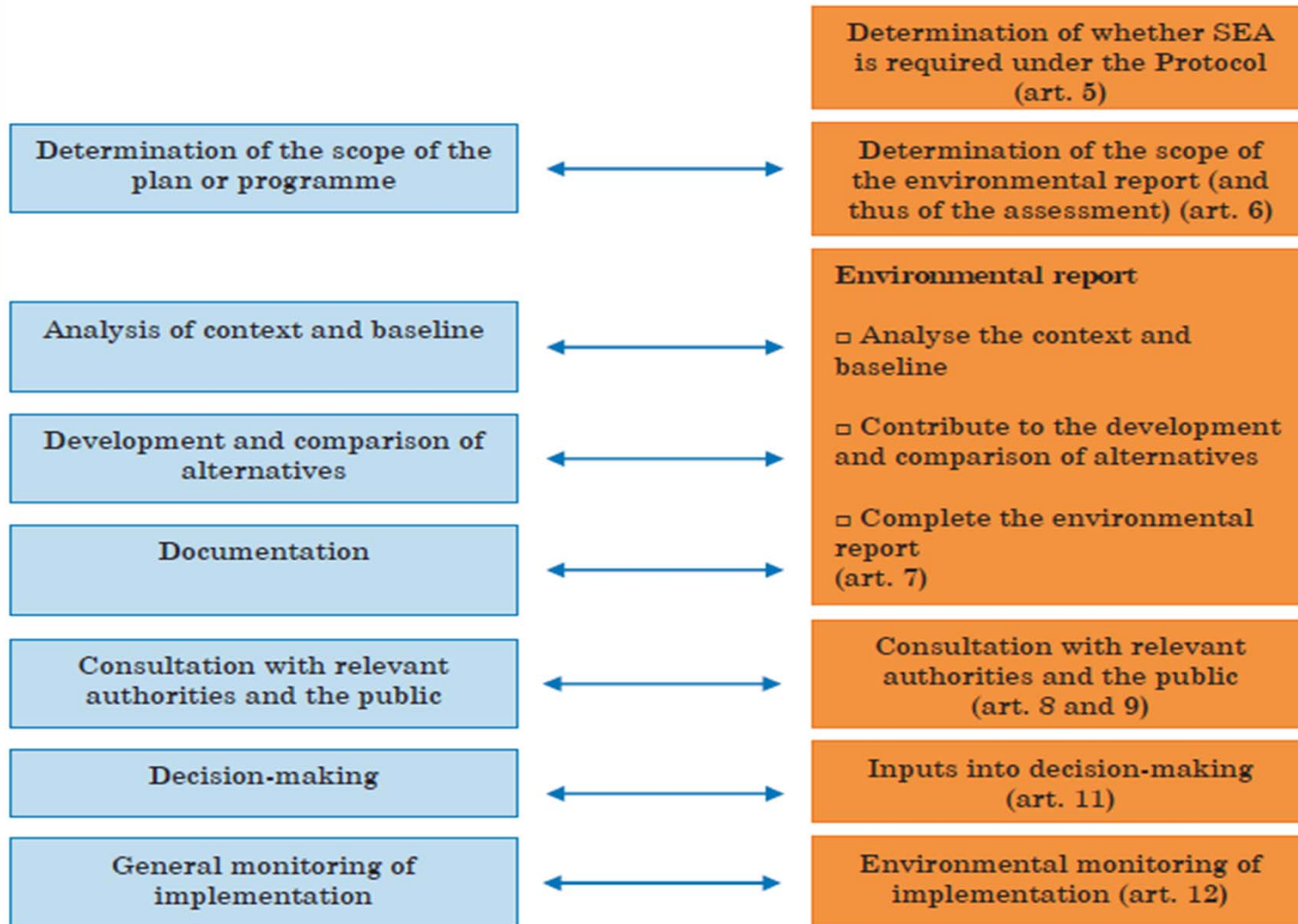


Generic SEA steps

- Screening (determining if SEA is required to be applied to the certain plan/programme);
- Scoping (setting the scope for the SEA, including a work-plan);
- Baseline analysis (analysis of the context, existing conditions and trends);
- Impact evaluation, including alternative, and formulation of mitigation measures (including monitoring);
- Compiling SEA report (or 'Environmental Report' as per the Protocol on SEA);
- Quality control of the SEA report,
- Inputs into decision-making; and
- Environmental monitoring of implementation.
