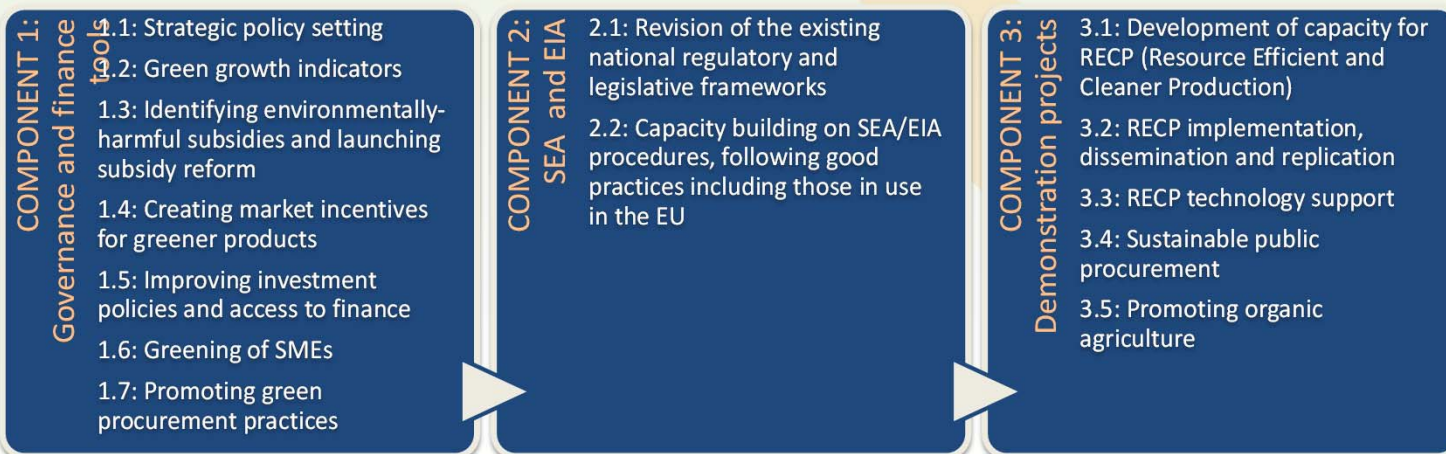
EaP GREEN: General Information(1)

- A major of sub regional program for **2013-2017 year**
- Implemented by UNECE, OECD, UNEP, and UNIDO
- Finance by EU, 4 implementing organizations and other donors
- Aim: assist Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, **Moldova** and Ukraine in their transition to a green economy

General Objective: Assist EaP countries to disrupt **economic growth** from environmental degradation and resource depletion

- SEA, EIA Pilot

- Legislative revision and preparation of recommendations
- Political dialogue
- Institutional assessment and developing recommendations
