Institutional framework on Sustainable Development in Romania — before Nov 2018



- The Inter-ministerial Committee for the Coordination of the Integration of Environmental Protection into Sectoral Policies and Strategies at the National Level, representing the main decision-making body for sustainable development in Romania – Lead by Vice prime Minister, Minister of Environment (established 2001/ reviewed 2011)
- The Sub-commission for Sustainable Development in the **Parliament of Romania** (2015)
- The Department for Sustainable Development **Prime-Minister Office**, lead by a State Counsellor/ main responsibility on the implementation of 2030 Agenda at national level. (2017)

Institutional framework on Sustainable Development in Romania – new SNDS Nov. 2018



- Establishing new dedicated structures:
 - **❖**The Inter-departmental Committee on SD under the PM coordination
 - **❖**The Council for SD personalities from academia and civil society representatives
- The Department for Sustainable Development Prime-Minister Office, main responsibility on the implementation of 2030 Agenda at national level. (2017);
- The Inter-ministerial Committee for the Coordination of the Integration of Environmental Protection into Sectoral Policies and Strategies at the National Level,— Lead by Vice prime Minister, Minister of Environment (established 2001/ reviewed 2011), main responsibility on the implementation of Environmental dimension of SD
- The Sub-commission for Sustainable Development in the Parliament of Romania (2015)

The Process of VNR elaboration



2017, 5th September – Inter-ministerial Committee (IC) Meeting:

- The elaboration of the Romania's National Voluntary Review, finalized in June 2018
- The reviewing process of the National Sustainable Development Strategy, finalized in October, approved on 9th November

VNR process - Ministry of Environment through the Secretariat of the IC Reviewing of the NSDS – Department for Sustainable Development/ Prime Minister Office

Civil society involvement – from the begging of the process

VNR – Open Working Group for VNR

NSDS – various debates with all stakeholders in all regions
