
SDGs in the 3rd EPR

**UNDA Project: Activity 1** 



- Assessing the most critical aspects and priority needs (per country)
  - Develop a review of the implementation of the recommendations coming from EPRs vis-à-vis SDGs and targets
  - Undertake a need assessment to determine and address gaps identified in the reviews between current conditions and desired achievements of relevant SDGs
  - Organize a workshop to present and validate the results of the reviews and needs assessments

- Developing and integrating evidence-based coherent environmental policies
  - Develop national action plans/policy packages
  - Organize five national validation workshops
  - Organise subregional policy seminar
  - Organise concluding subregional event
