Serbian Commissioner can update the Draft report in the point 12) on page 50, "Important cases".  
We recommend to add the following text to previous comment:

*As of October 2018, public concern was raised on the issues of polluted river Morava and construction of Small hydropower plants. Commissioner received 5 complaints of which four are lodged for ignoring the requests of applicants, and one was lodged against a decision or conclusion of authority. Further five requests for information were received, of which three were requests for statistical evidence on cases relating to environmental protection, whereas two were requests for information relating to construction of small hydropower plants and documents pertaining to it.*
