Request to the Chair of the Compliance Committee

On 1 September 2020 the Ministry of Environment of the Republic of Lithuania received a letter from the Compliance Committee of the Aarhus Convention informing about agreed draft findings regarding communication ACCC/C/2013/98. The Party Concerned (Lithuania) was invited to provide its comments by Tuesday, 13 October 2020.

We would like to thank the Compliance Committee and the Secretariat for the work done. We analysed draft findings and recommendations in detail and we will have comments on it. As this draft document covers number of topics related to different institutions and their competences, the process of comments' preparation was not as fluent and fast as expected. Moreover, we are still waiting for the translation of the document supporting our comments (we should receive it at the end of this week) which will help to finalise our remarks.

In the light of what has been said above, on behalf of the Party Concerned I would like to ask the Chair of the Compliance Committee to extend the above mentioned deadline by one week (until the 20 October 2020).
