## II. Introduction

1. The fifth session of the Meeting of the Parties (MOP-5) to the Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters (Aarhus Convention) and the second session of the Meeting of the Parties to the Protocol on Pollutant Release and Transfer Registers (Protocol on PRTRs) to the Aarhus Convention (MOPP-2) will be held from 30 June to 4 July 2014, with a Joint High-level Segment on 2 July. The events will take place in Maastricht, the Netherlands, at the invitation of the Government of the Netherlands.

2. The High-level Segment will target high-level officials, including ministers, vice-ministers, State secretaries, other heads of delegations and special guests, and its thematic session will be dedicated to the themes to be addressed in the Maastricht Declaration (see the draft Declaration ECE/MP.PP/2014/L.26–ECE/MP.PRTR/2014/L.1).<sup>1</sup>

3. The High-level Segment will be chaired by a high-level official of the host country and will have the format of a panel discussion involving ministers, non-governmental organizations and other stakeholders with strong expertise in the theme of the session, followed by a general debate. The discussion will be facilitated by a moderator. The substantive focus of the High-level Segment will be based on the themes of the draft Maastricht Declaration. The session is expected, among others, to provide input to the work on the future sustainable development agenda following the United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development in 2012 (Rio+20 Conference) and setting and implementing relevant Millennium Development or future Sustainable Development Goals. A provisional programme for thematic session (AC/MOP-5/Inf.1–PRTR/MOPP-2/Inf.1) will provide further details on the themes and speakers.<sup>2</sup>

## III. Annotations to the provisional agenda

### 1. Opening of the Joint High-level Segment

*Timing: Wednesday, 2 July, 10 a.m.*

4. The Joint High-level Segment will begin with a welcome address by a high-level official from the host country and the Executive Secretary of the Economic Commission for Europe.
