Item 4: Budva Declaration on Environmental Democracy for Our Sustainable Future

Excellencies,
Distinguished delegates,
Ladies and Gentlemen,

I am speaking on behalf of the EU and its Member States.

First of all I would like to thank the Government of Montenegro and the city of Budva for doing an excellent job in hosting the 6th Meeting of the Parties of the Aarhus Convention and the 3rd Meeting of the Parties of the PRTR Protocol. I would also like to thank the Aarhus Secretariat for its contribution to the organization of this important meeting.

The European Union and its Member States support the Budva Declaration, which is the result of inclusive and constructive discussions among Parties, Signatories and stakeholders.

We welcome the fact that the Budva declaration addresses the role of the Aarhus Convention and the PRTR Protocol in leading and inspiring actions to promote democracy and the rule of law in environmental matters, helping to strengthen the involvement of civil society, local communities, academic institutions and marginalized groups, in decision-making. We stress the importance of finding ways to ensure effective safety for environmental activists and whistleblowers.

Finally, we would like to reaffirm the strong commitment of the EU and its Member States to promote and implement the principles of the Convention and the Protocol.
