The present document is being submitted in view of the Working Group's mandate to prepare the sessions of the Meeting of the Parties (ECE/MP.PP/2/Add.15, para. 2 (a)). The document, prepared by the Bureau of the Meeting of the Parties to the Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters, sets out a draft provisional agenda for the fifth session of the Meeting of the Parties, to be held in Maastricht, the Netherlands, from 30 June to 2 July 2014. An outline of the draft agenda (ECE/MP.PP/WG.1/2013/13)<sup>1</sup> was considered by the Working Group of the Parties at its sixteenth meeting (Geneva, 19–21 June 2013). The Working Group requested the Bureau to prepare a draft provisional agenda for the fifth session of the Meeting of the Parties on the basis of that outline and in the light of the comments made at the meeting, for submission to the Working Group at its seventeenth meeting for consideration, revision and approval (ECE/MP.PP/WG.1/2013/2, para. 66),<sup>2</sup> and asked that the draft be distributed to Parties and stakeholders for comments. The document was so circulated, but no comments were received.

The Bureau reviewed the document at its thirty-second meeting (Geneva, 2–3 December 2013) and is submitting the present draft for the further consideration of the Working Group, which is expected to approve the document at its seventeenth meeting and

submit it to the Meeting of the Parties for its consideration at its fifth session.

## I. Introduction

1. The fifth session of the Meeting of the Parties (MOP-5) to the Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters (Aarhus Convention) will be held from 30 June to 2 July 2014 in Maastricht, the Netherlands, at the invitation of the Government of the Netherlands. The session will be preceded on Sunday, 29 June, by the meetings of the Compliance Committee (scheduled for a full day, with the possibility of continuing in parallel with MOP-5, as needed), the Bureau (morning), and the Working Group of the Parties (afternoon). The Compliance Committee, the Bureau and the Working Group of the Parties will consider, respectively, any possible open issues, as appropriate.
2. MOP-5 will consist of a General Segment and a High-level Segment. The general segment will take place on Monday, 30 June, and on Tuesday, 1 July.
3. MOP-5 and the second session of the Meeting of the Parties to the Protocol on Pollutant Release and Transfer Registers (MOPP-2) will be held back to back, with a joint High-level Segment in the middle, on Wednesday, 2 July.
4. The High-level Segment will target high-level officials, including ministers, vice-ministers, State secretaries, other heads of delegations and special guests, and its thematic session will be dedicated to the themes to be addressed in the Maastricht Declaration.<sup>3</sup>
5. The High-level Segment will be chaired by a high-level official of the host country and will have the format of a panel discussion involving ministers, non-governmental organizations and other stakeholders with strong expertise in the theme of the session, followed by a general debate. The session will provide input to the work on the future sustainable development agenda following the United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development in 2012 (Rio+20 Conference), and setting and implementing relevant Millennium Development or future Sustainable Development Goals.
6. The envisaged allocation of time for MOP-5 and MOPP-2 and the associated meetings is set out in the table below.
