Perspectives on short to long-term

- **Short-term (Mid-2017)**: Mapping of different actions at EU level (research, capacity-building), EU-funded project database with a searching capacity per theme, including on industrial safety and security: **ACCESSING INFORMATION**
- **Medium-term (from mid-2017 onward)**: Stronger links among on-going and future research and capacity-building projects, policy sectors and practitioners in view of improving synergies – Aim of the Community of Users: **REINFORCING DIALOGUE**
- **Long-term (3-5 years horizon)**: Consolidation of the CoU exchange platform with expected supporting impact on EU Research / Capacity-Building and Policy implementation – Enhanced links with users, return of experiences from industry and practitioners (access to market, involvement of first responders) – **NEW WORKING RELATIONSHIPS, CONFIDENCE BUILDING**
