Statement by Tamara GUVIR, Republic of Moldova

In 2000, the Republic of Moldova signed the Protocol on Water and Health committing for its implementation.

At the present day, in our country are prepared the documents for the ratification of Protocol – an important tool for Convention implementation, witch will contribute at pollution reduction of waters, also at reduction of water diseases in transboundary context.

Participating (period 2002-2003) at the elaboration of an very important and useful document, for the prevention of water pollution and about countries transboundary liability in this field, such as Protocol on Civil Liability, the Republic of Moldova has assumed the responsibility of accomplishing the foresights of the above mentioned Protocol. The firs step was the signing of the mentioned document at the Ministerial Conference “Environment for Europe”, held in Kiev, May 2003.

Participating at the Third Meeting of the Parties, the Republic of Moldova communicates that it agrees and considers that the proposal, made by Switzerland, on the amendment to the Convention, is very welcomed, and sustain integral this proposal. We consider that this amendment will enhance the role of Convention in solving the environmental problems and also will fortify the development of sustainable management of transboundary water sources.
