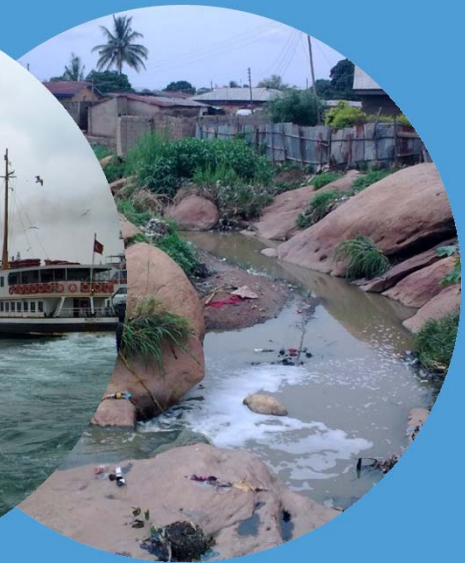

# Rationale

- Serve as complement to the *Guidance on Water and Adaptation to Climate Change*

In close cooperation with INBO (International Network of Basin Organizations)

# Process

- 9-10 December 2013 Drafting group
  - Discussion on content and process
- Input from network
- Selection of lessons learned and good practices
- Drafting of report / case study descriptions
- Review by
  - Task Force on Water and Climate
  - Working Group on Integrated Water Resources Management
- Present at World Water Forum, Korea 2015

- Long list of lessons learned from:
  - Presentations
  - Reports from workshops
  - Literature survey
- Need for practical examples

# How to identify case studies?

- Pilot projects
- Other presentations from workshops
- Suggestions by countries
- Basins worldwide
- Call for case studies on the basis of lessons learned

# Blending

- Case studies vs lessons learned
- Develop matrix
  - More than 1 lesson per case?
  - More than 1 case per lesson?

# Case description

- Geographical delineation
- Problem situation, including climate change
- Institutional setting where relevant
- How the problem situation was solved or mitigated
  - What is the lesson learned?
  - How did it work in practice?
- Also 'bad' practices
