Task Force on Target Setting and Reporting

The Task Force on Target Setting and Reporting, led by Switzerland, provides guidance to Parties to implement articles 6 (targets and target dates) and 7 of the Protocol (review and assessment of progress), in particular by promoting the implementation of the [Guidelines on the setting of targets, evaluation of progress and reporting](#), as well as the [Guidelines and template for summary reports](#). It also promotes exchange of experience between Parties on the implementation of the Protocol and harmonization in the region.

The Task Force on Target Setting and Reporting was renamed at the second Meeting of the Parties in 2010 after the Task Force on Indicators and Reporting, initially established by the first Meeting of the Parties to the Protocol on Water and Health in 2007.

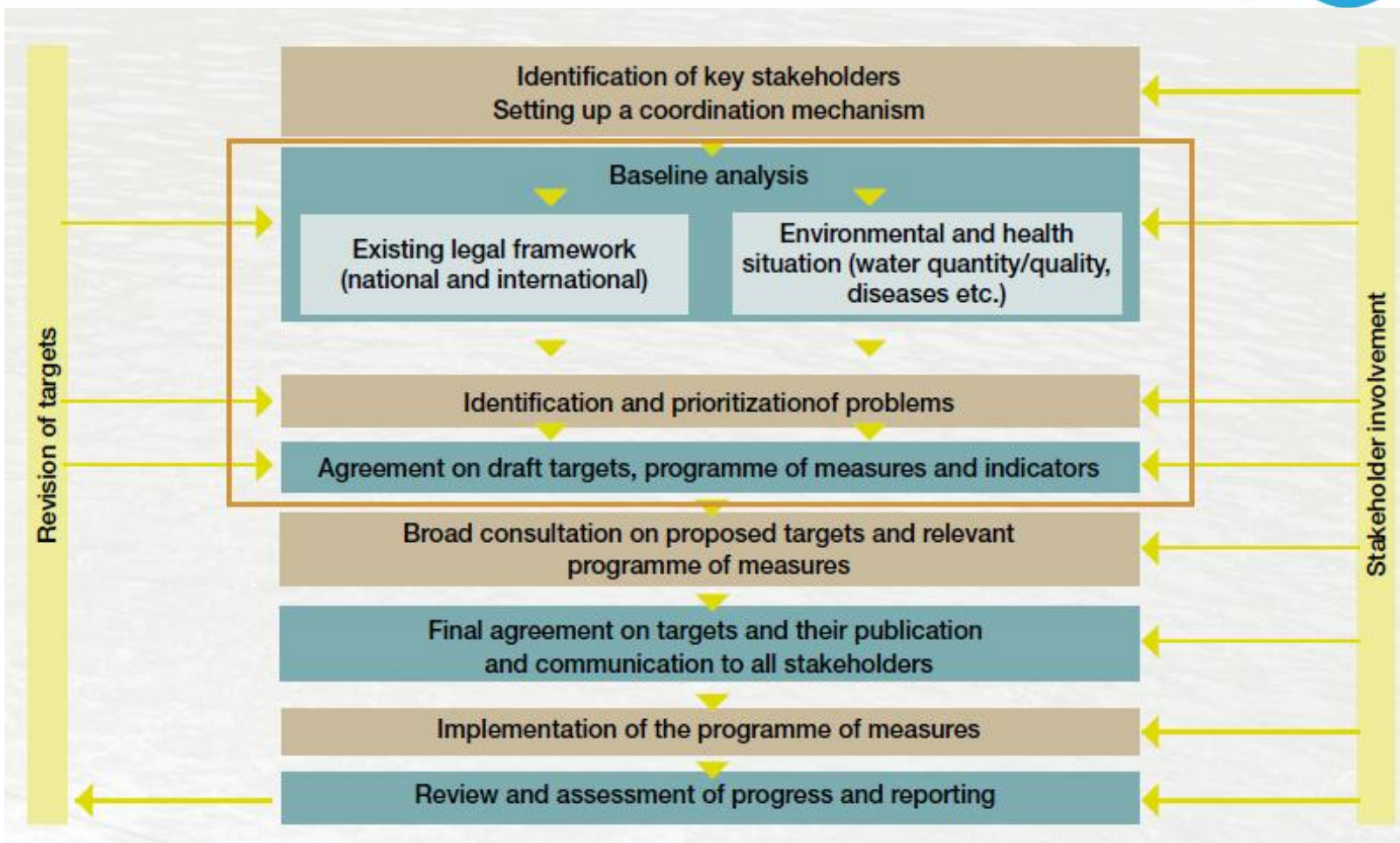

National summary report



- Second reporting exercise
- Status of the implementation of the Protocol
- In accordance with the Guidelines on reporting
- Deadline for submission: 29 April, 2013

Template for reporting



1. Background
2. Common indicators
3. Targets and target achievements
4. Overall situation
5. Information on the persons preparing the report

Common indicators



It is mandatory to report on:

- Access to safe water
- Access to improved sanitation
- Drinking water quality
- Reduction of water related diseases
- Effectiveness of management, protection and use of freshwater resources

Challenges in reporting



- The collection of the necessary data is often a nightmare. It reveals a lack of information
- This report can not be established by one single entity
- It is essential to involve the main stakeholders and get their supports

Objectives of the workshop



- Exchange of experiences and lessons learned by Parties and non-Parties
- Present and discuss the process of preparation of the summary reports
- Discuss the preliminary results of the reporting exercise at the national level
