Progress and activities in this area of work in late 2016-2017

Afghan-Tajik cooperation on the Pyanj river (upper Amu Darya)

- * A hydrology training course and an expedition was organised to Pyanj basin in October 2016.
- * The exchange of hydrological data between the two countries continued in 2016
- * MoU between Afghanistan and Tajikistan – autumn 2017
- * Afghan-Tajik environmental seminar and expedition with environmental and hydrology elements are planned to be conducted in 2017
- * Implemented in cooperation with OSCE and CAREC

Progress and activities in this area of work in late 2016-2017

Cooperation on water quality

- * Project supported establishment of Regional Working Group on Water Quality that has elaborated a workplan, which has 3 broad areas:
 1. Development of a knowledge product on water quality at the regional level;
 2. Support activities related to water quality for specialists in CA countries;
 3. Joint water quality monitoring

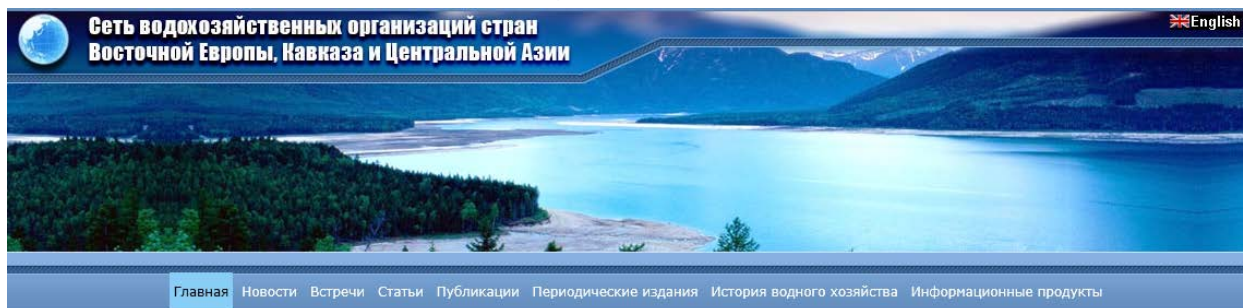
Dam safety

- * Continued support to develop national legal and institutional frameworks for dam safety in Tajikistan and Kazakhstan; initiated in Kyrgyzstan
- * A new safety monitoring system on the Ortotokoi dam in Kyrgyzstan is established – fully functional
- * On the regional level: a model national regulation for the establishment of a cadastre for hydro-technical installations and a report on recent global developments in dam safety was produced
- * Project evaluation for the phase 2014-2016

Progress and activities in this area of work in late 2016-2017

Support to the network of Russian-speaking water management organizations

- Implemented in collaboration with Scientific Information Centre, International Commission for Water Coordination, Uzbekistan (SIC-ICWC)
- Conference May 2017, network website, atlas

EU funded project - Supporting Kazakhstan's transition to a Green Economy

Activity 1.1. Transboundary Water Management

- * Development of a review and recommendations on the policy of Kazakhstan for trans-boundary water cooperation
- * Training and development of training manuals for university teachers (four aspects of water management (economy, technology, policy, and law)
- * Training and development of training manuals for civil servants (German Kazakh University, State Academy) (planned)

Progress and activities in this area of work in late 2016-2017

Agreement on the management of transboundary watercourses shared by Georgia and Azerbaijan

- * Report on Kura river water use, water demand and water status (Feb 2017)
- * Basis for finalization of draft agreement on the cooperation in protection and sustainable use of the water resources in the Kura river basin
- * Next meeting is planned in Tbilisi (September)

Progress and activities in this area of work in late 2016-2017

GEF projects

- * Dniester project (managed by OSCE) – Project is being initiated
- * Drin project (implemented by GWP) – UNECE will contribute to the implementation
- * Chu Talas – (UNDP Kyrgyzstan) implemented in coordination with UNECE project *Enhancing Climate Resilience and Adaptive Capacity in the transboundary Chu-Talas Basin.*
