

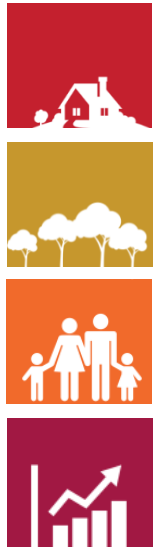

# Joint Task Force on Energy Efficiency Standards in Buildings: Planned Activities

ENERGY



- a) Mapping energy efficiency standards in buildings and preparing gap analyses
- b) Evaluating options for the development, adoption or promotion of energy efficiency standards in buildings
- c) Preparing guidance materials
- d) Promoting partnerships with other international organizations
- e) Establishing a network of experts on EE in buildings
- f) Developing and organizing training programmes

# Joint Task Force on Energy Efficiency Standards in Buildings: Funding

- Supported by extra-budgetary funds and in-kind contributions
- Extra-budgetary project on EE Standards in Buildings: funding provided by Governments of Denmark and Russian Federation – under implementation since August 2017

- Mapping of energy efficiency standards in buildings in the UNECE region
- Development of best practices for existing standards and technologies
- Establishment of an online database of experts on energy efficiency in buildings
- Mapping of existing technologies to enhance energy efficiency in buildings, gap analysis and recommendations for their use in the region
