Information Notice

Background

The Team of Specialists on Women's Entrepreneurship was established at the second session of the Working Party on Industry and Enterprise Development (W.P.8) in 2001 TRADE/WP.8/2001/5). The Team reports to the Working Party on Industry and Enterprise Development (W.P.8) and operates within the mandate and procedures established for its teams of specialists (TRADE/WP.8/2002/7).

The mission of the Team of Specialists is to assist Governments and women in the ECE region in fully utilizing women's skills, knowledge and entrepreneurial potential to stimulate economic growth and job creation in their countries, which is a condition to improve living conditions and alleviate poverty. To this end, the Team of Specialists:

- collects information on the situation of women-entrepreneurs and identifies gender specific barriers to entrepreneurship in countries and sub-regions;
- collects best practices of national policies supporting women's entrepreneurship in the ECE region;
- organizes the exchange of information and experiences involving governments, business community and civil society;
- prepares recommendations how to incorporate concerns of women-entrepreneurs into institutional and legal frameworks for business activities and address other gender specific barriers;
- promotes organization of training courses and life-long learning for women -entrepreneurs to facilitate start-ups and developing business activities under the conditions of globalization and rapid progress in information and communication technologies (ICT);
- creates a web-site within the framework of the UNECE web-system in cooperation with the participating specialists in order to expand networks among women-entrepreneurs, improve access to information; and raises the awareness in the member States on women's

entrepreneurship through the enlargement of the UNECE Portrait Gallery of Excellent Women Entrepreneurs and other relevant activities.

Summary of the third meeting

The third meeting of the Team of Specialists (TOS) on Women's Entrepreneurship was held at the Palais de Nations, Geneva on 19 March 2003. It was organised by the Industrial Restructuring, Energy and Enterprise Development Division (IREEDD) of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE). The meeting was attended by 20 members.

During the meeting the following officials were elected for the period of March 2003-February 2004: Chair: Mr. A. Fiddaman, Director, The Prince of Wales International Business Leaders Forum (UK) and Deputy –Chair: Ms. Elzbieta Raciniewska, Senior Specialist, Ministry of Economy, Labour and Social Affairs (Poland).

It was decided to follow up to the Second Forum through the organisation of sub-regional and national events. The programme of work for 2003 - 2004 was adopted; it is included into the Summery Report attached.

The Teams established four sub-regional initiative Groups in Belarus and Ukraine, in Russia, in Central Asia and in South Caucasus; it also established two thematic groups: one on training and human recourses and one on data and statistics.
