- Achieve visibility to convince policymakers of the usefulness of endeavours such as the GGP

- Format:  
High-level expert meeting with policymakers
- Envisaged time and place:  
1<sup>st</sup> half of May 2008, back-to-back with a shortened meeting of the IWG, in Geneva
- Content:  
covering all the key policy areas where analyses of the GGP can make a significant contribution
- Macro and micro level approach to each topic
- Output: publication of proceedings
