8th GGP NNFP meeting

The Russian GGP includes 2 parts:

- **Generations and Gender Survey**
 - **1st wave** - *Conducted in 2004*
opened to international users
 - **2nd wave** – *Conducted in 2007*
data harmonization this summer
plan to be opened in 2012
 - **3rd wave** – *Conducting in 2011 (this summer)*
- **Contextual Databases:** *completed in 2006*

Generations and Gender Surveys in Russia: 3rd wave

- ❑ 2010: economic crisis (↗ costs and ↘ funding)
 - + population census (new general total; coincidence of terms)
 - (BUT: another research on GGS subsample was conducted)
 - ❑ 2011: 3rd wave is conducting by the IISP with the financial support of the Pension Fund of the Russian Federation and Russian Savings Bank “Sberbank Rossii”
- Commercial funding
- ❑ The design and standard survey instruments of the GGS were adjusted to the Russian context by the IISP and the Demoscope Independent Research Center (partner for the field works)

Generations and Gender Surveys in Russia: 3rd wave

Phase	Process / terms
Fund-raising	making a contracts
Preparing questionnaires	finished
Field works	planned for summer 2011
First results	autumn 2011
Cleaned data	spring 2012
Data opening	not early than 2014-2015

Sampling of RusGGS-2011

- 2 tasks (as in 2007): panel analysis + representative cross-sectional analysis by date
- 3 types of sample to construct one
 - Panel – 22-86 years old (incl. 25-86 from 1 wave)
 - New respondents of 21 to 79 to replace those who left
 - Special screening – new respondents of 18-20 years old

RusGGS-2011: Two Questionnaires

**Panel sample =
2004&2007 or 2007**

Panel Questionnaire

- 65-70% of respondents from 2 wave (expected)
- Full version

Repair

18-20

Questionnaire for newcomers

- 30-35% of respondents
- Shortened version

Questionnaires Adaptation: Excluded Core Questions

- **Both questionnaires exclude:**
 - Activity and Education History
 - Detailed data on a P's educational and occupational characteristics
 - Some attitudes, except for those related to gender and intergenerational issues
 - Contraception
 - Housework division
 - Emotional state, satisfaction with personal relationships (children, partner, parents) and satisfaction with current status, some intentions
- **The questionnaire for newcomers also excludes:**
 - Details of parents' situation – living arrangements, need for care, etc.
 - Monetary transfers

Questionnaires Adaptation: Added Questions

- Pension reform module
- Population policy module (new)
- Alimony module
- Date of entry to current statuses (of R / P)
- Housing conditions
- More details of R's employment:
 - sector
 - informal payments
- Savings, credits, bank accounts...

Additional Assistance & Support Required

- Training in Panel Analysis
- Technical and financial assistance in GGS 2nd wave data harmonization (to be opened in 2012)
- Additional financial resources for analytical work
- Financial resources for the further GGS waves
