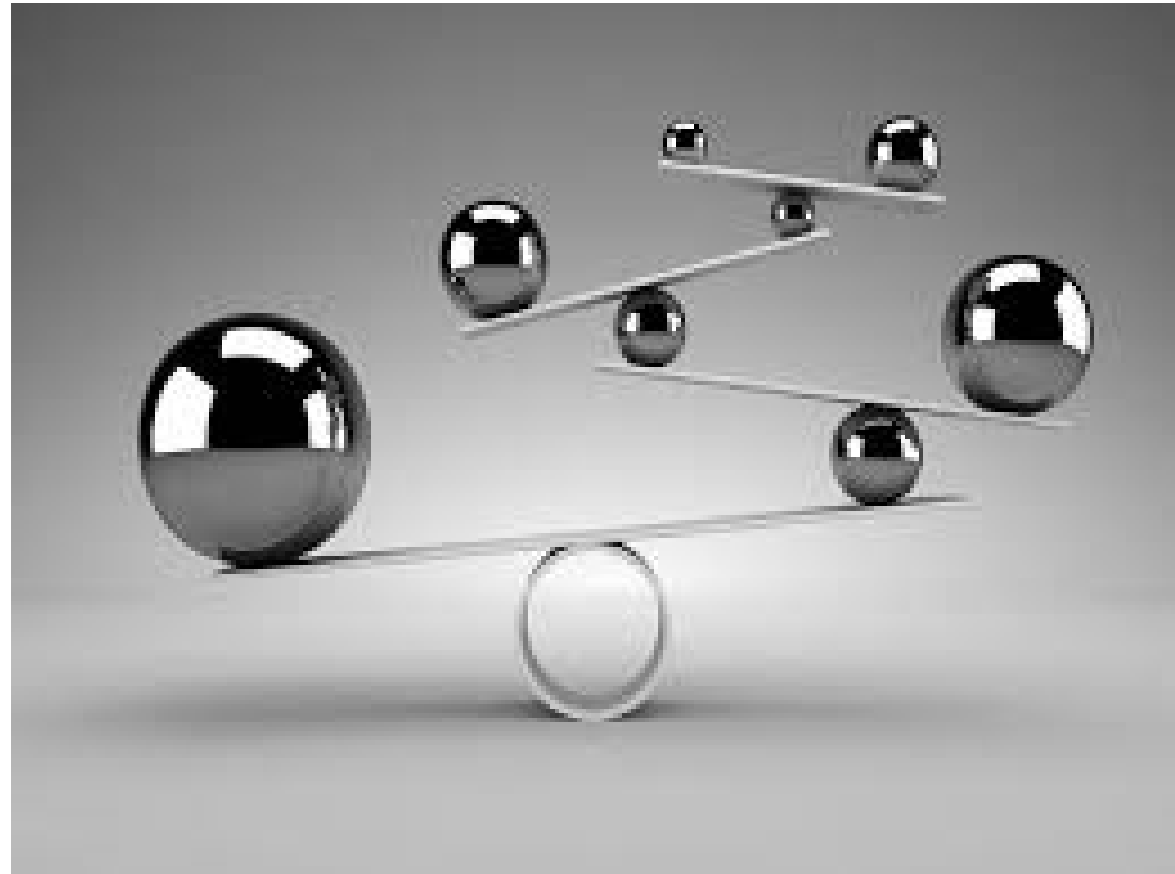

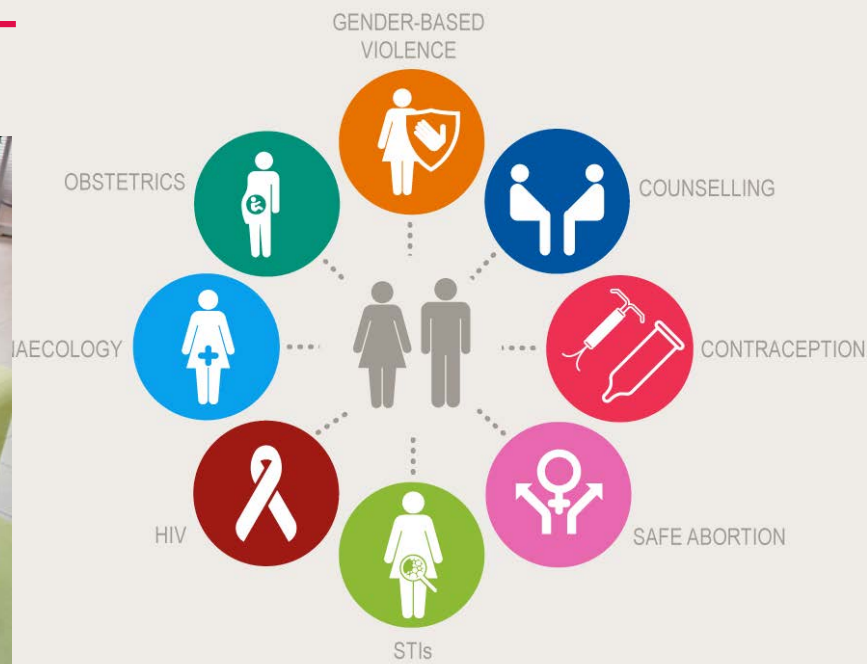
Sexuality Education in the WHO European Region

Recommendations

- **Ensure a LEGAL and SOCIAL sustainable environment free from violence and pressure for CSOs to contribute to society and policy making.**
Ensure in particular the protection of human rights and women rights defenders to participate in the country's public and policy debates.
- **Increase political leadership and strategic investment, including increased earmarked budget, for SRH, support effective measures to fight gender based violence, support for mandatory comprehensive sexuality education, access to contraception and choice, safe motherhood and safe abortion care, HIV and STI prevention, treatment and care, especially for those furthest behind.**
