National multilevel co-managed coordination of active ageing policies in Italy

- **Overall aim:** To activate a shared intervention model for policy making and policy implementation in the field of active ageing
- **Shared** = different stakeholders at different geographical and governmental levels
- **3-years project** – Pilot project in sight of a possible (next) Italian Active Ageing Strategy

Mains steps

- **September 2017** – Expression of interest between INRCA and the Department for Family Policies (DIPOFAM) at the Presidency of the Council of Ministers during the UNECE Ministerial Conference on Ageing in Lisbon
- **December 2018** – Agreement between the parties
- **April 2019** – Kick-off project meeting in Rome
- **May 2019** – Presentation of the project to stakeholders and the general public during the PA's yearly forum (Rome)
- **June 2019** – Plenary meeting with stakeholders (Rome)
- **September 2019** – Beginning of the fieldwork

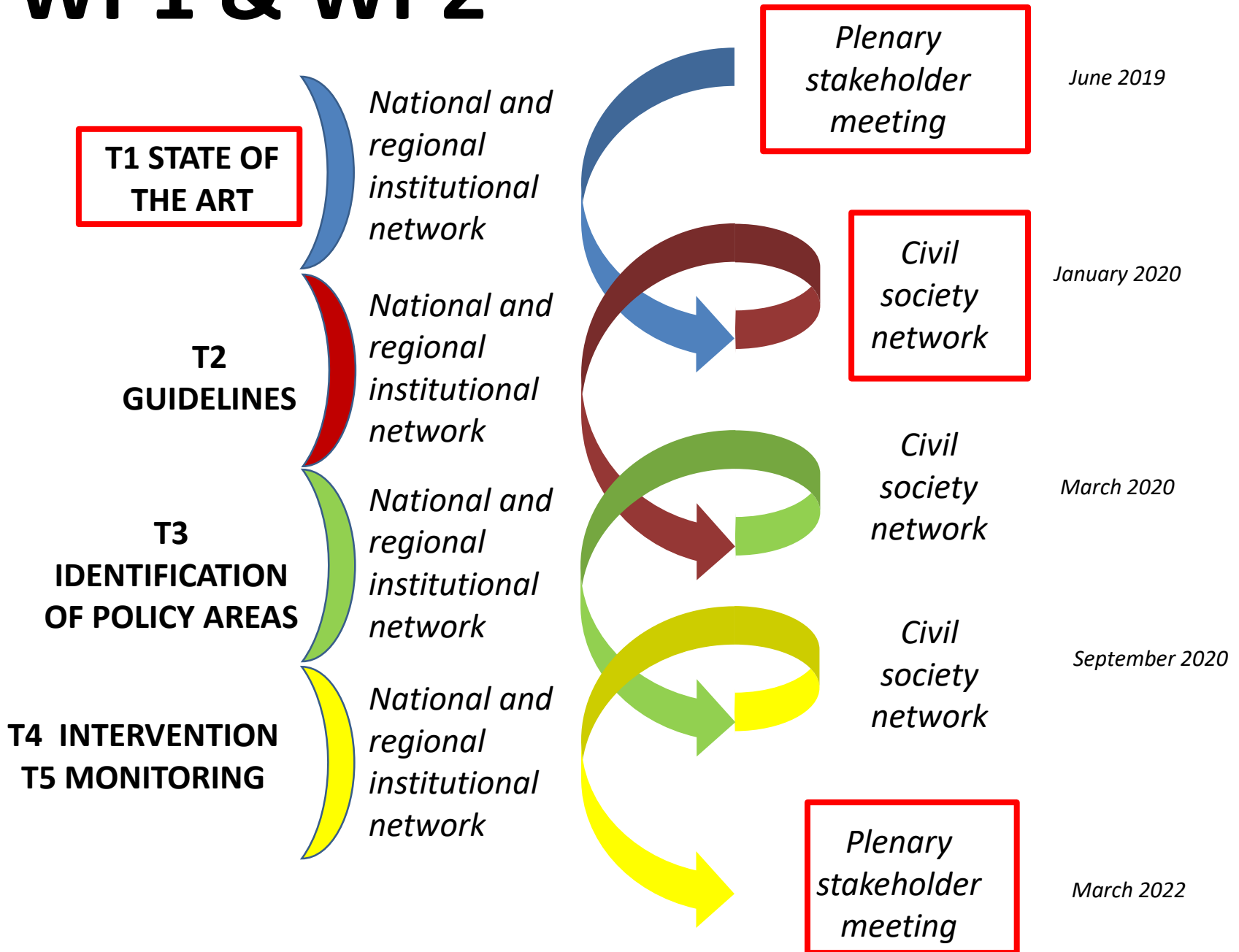

Definition of active ageing adopted

Activities by older people in the following fields:

- social participation
- volunteering/civic engagement
- education/training
- work in the labour market
- culture
- tourism
- sport
- leisure
- informal elder care
- grandparenting
- agriculture/gardening
- co-housing
- other...

The definition does not include policies focused on older people as passive people in need of health and/or social services (i.e. the project is not about care policies, it is about the activation of older people)

T1 – Topic guide for interviews

Main aim:

- To gather information (through documents) regarding the state of the art on active ageing policies**
- To understand (through interviews) the extent to which documents are applied in real life**
