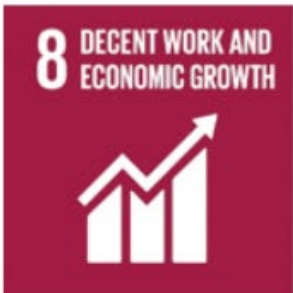

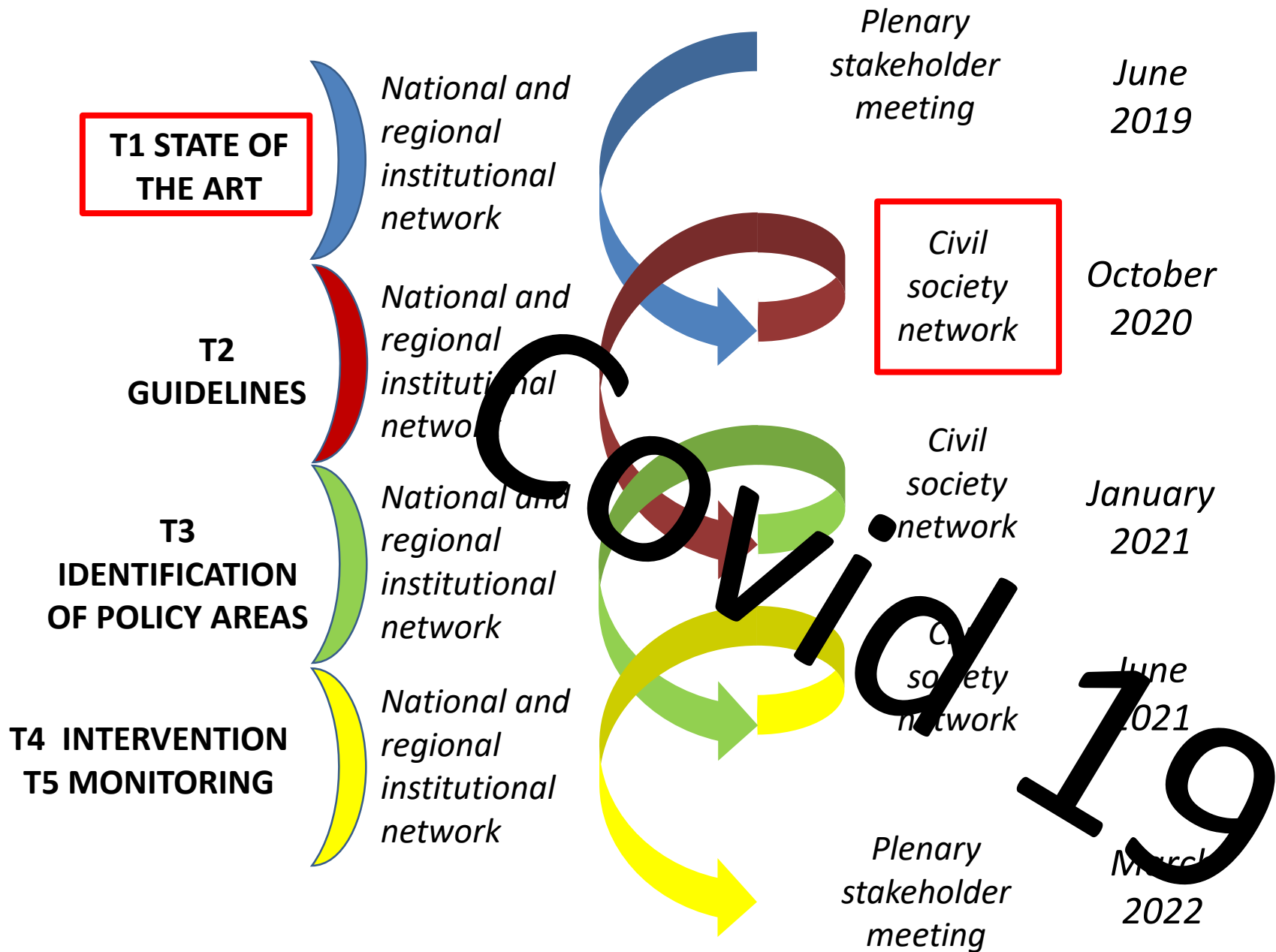

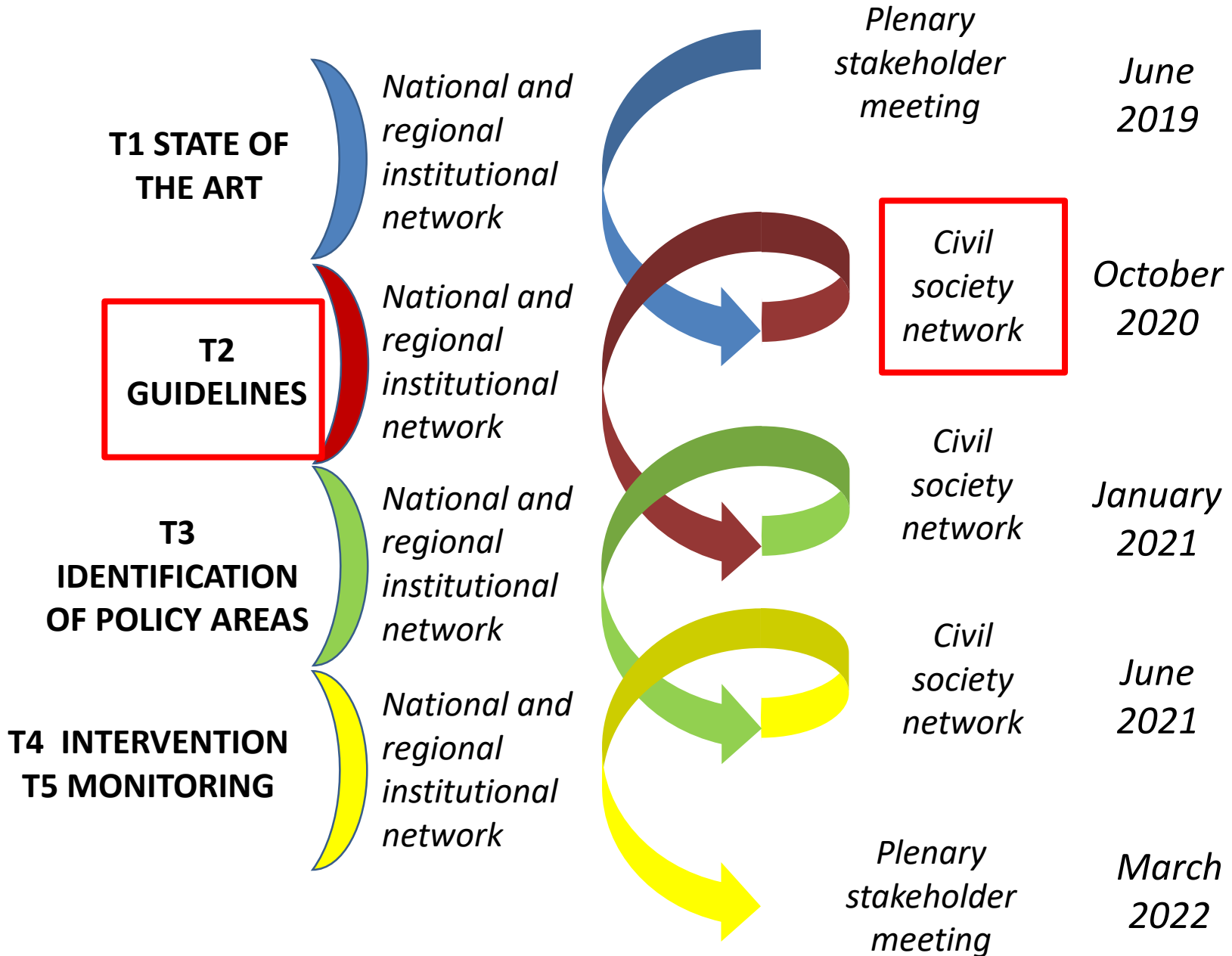

Guidelines for policy making on the topic of active ageing

- **Overall aim:** Indications and recommendations for policy making in this field based on:
 - a) the results of the analysis of the state of the art (e.g. good practices);
 - b) further inputs from the stakeholder network.
- **Method:** Consultative/Co-decisional process with exchanges between the project team and the stakeholder network.
- **Expected result:** Comprehensive (national) guidelines to be used in different geographical/institutional contexts
