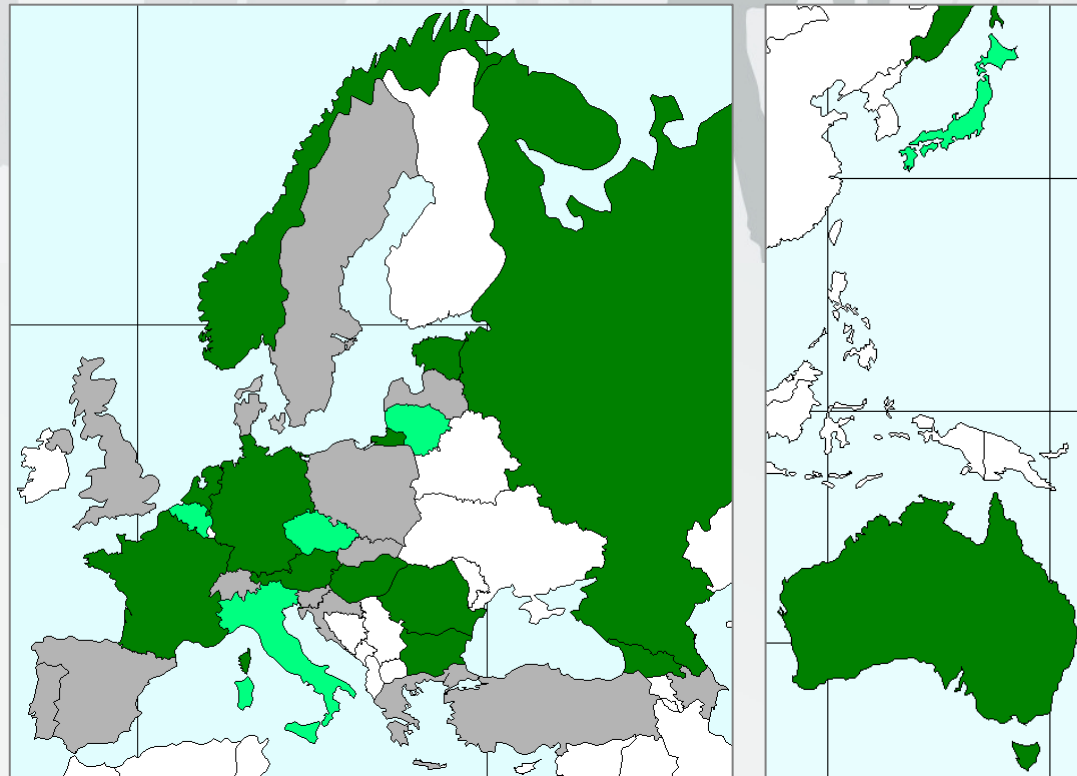

Contextual database

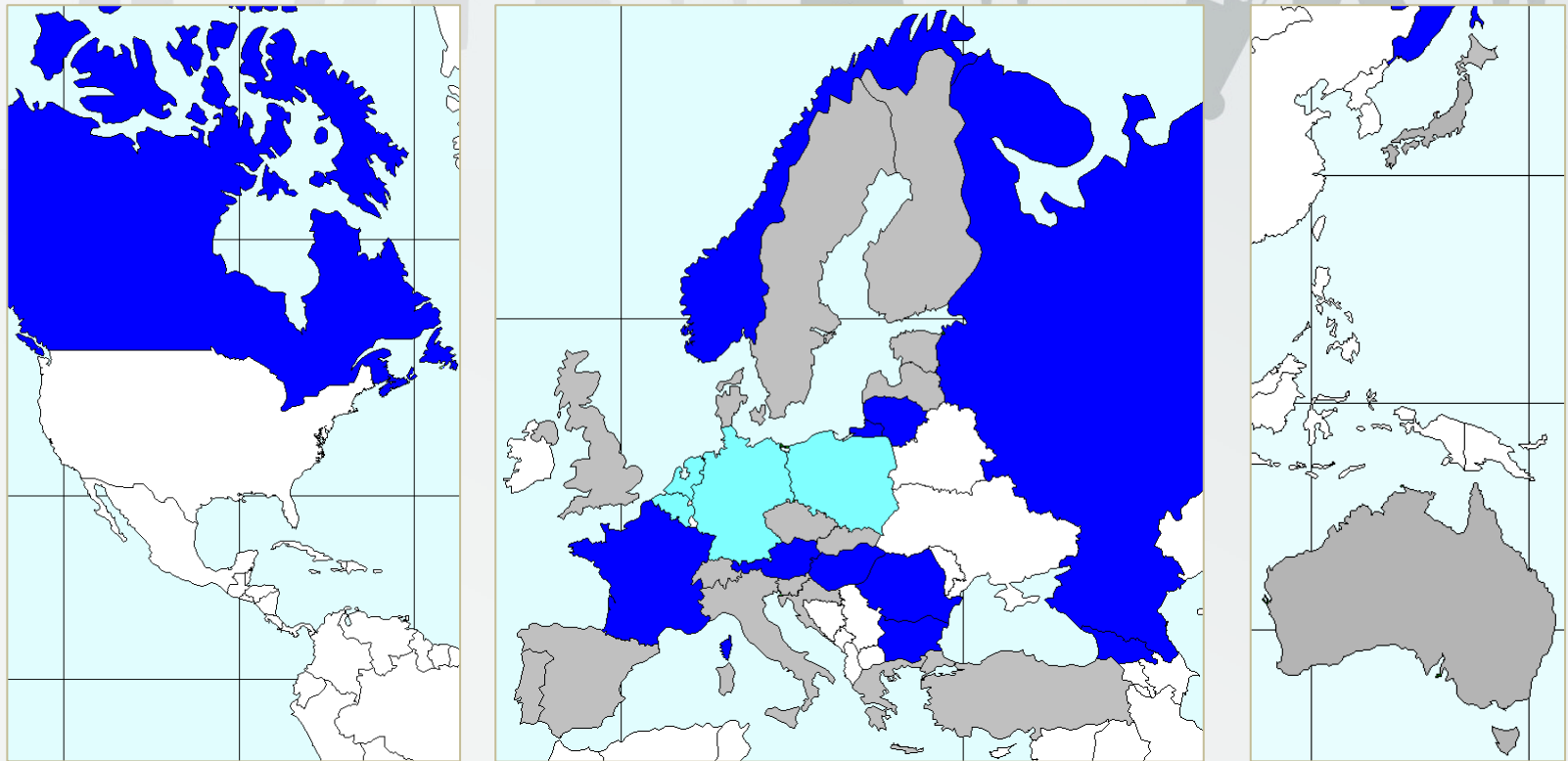
- ❖ 10 countries already online:
