- 7. Should we try to influence administrative concepts (e.g. accounting standards), and how?
- 8. How to deal with differences between administrative units (e.g. tax reporting units) and statistical units (e.g. statistical enterprises)?
- 9. Does one size fit all? Can SMEs and large enterprises be dealt with in the same way?
