

Figure 1. Life Expectancy at Birth by Sex for Selected Countries: 2000






Figure 3. Years of Life Expectancy at Birth by Sex in Four Countries: 1950-2000


Figure 4. Maternal Mortality Ratios for Romania: 1985-1993

Deaths per 100,000 live births






Figure 6. Percent of People With Completed Secondary Education or More



Figure 7. Percent of Professional Degrees Earned by Women in the United States: 1970-1998





Figure 8. Economically Active Population, by Age and Sex for Zimbabwe, Peru, and the United States





Figure 11. Number of Workers Aged 15 to 64, by Sex and Occupation in Malaysia: 2000






Figure 12. Women's Average Annual Income as a Percent of Men's for Full-Time Workers: Late 1990s
