INFORMATION NOTICE FOR PARTICIPANTS

In accordance with the work program of the Conference of European Statisticians for 2002-2003, the UNECE Work Session on Statistical Output for Dissemination to Information Media will take place in Geneva, Switzerland, 28-30 October 2002.

I. TIME AND PLACE OF THE MEETING

The Work Session on Statistical Output for Dissemination to Information Media will be held in the UN premises at Palais des Nations, 8-14 avenue de la Paix, Geneva, Switzerland.

The Work Session will start at 9:30 on Monday, 28 October 2002 and is scheduled to finish on Wednesday, 30 October 2002, at 17:30.

II. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Work Session will be conducted in English only. The papers will not be translated and should, therefore, be submitted in English.

The papers should not exceed 10 pages and should be submitted along with a short summary. The deadline for submission of papers was 15 August 2002. However, the secretariat can accept papers sent after this deadline. Contributions should be sent in electronic form preferably by e-mail (tiina.luige@unece.org) in Word Perfect, Word or ASCII format.

The agenda items will be considered based on two main categories of papers, **invited** papers and **contributed** papers. The organisers of the meeting have contacted a small number of countries and asked them to prepare invited papers for specific items. The invited papers will provide the main basis for discussion. However, issues raised in the other papers that countries contribute to the meeting (contributed papers) will also be considered during the substantive discussion.

Consideration of individual agenda items will be led by Session Discussant. The sessions will start with the presentation of the invited papers, followed by a brief question period. The Discussants will then introduce the contributed papers. The authors will have an opportunity to comment briefly on their papers and to answer any questions.

III. THE PRELIMINARY AGENDA

3. Session A: Review of the draft of the "Statistics in the media – handbook on best practices for statistical offices in dealing with the media".

It is planned to devote most of the time of the Work Session to the review of the draft of the *Handbook*. The draft was prepared in the UNECE by Laszlo Holka. It follows the outline of the publication as considered at the Work Session on Statistical Output for Dissemination to Information Media (September 2000, Voorburg, the Netherlands). Papers from the previous meetings on this topic and some methodological materials prepared by the UNECE Statistical Division provide the main basis for the draft *Handbook*. However, as some of the papers date from 5-6 years ago, a considerable review is needed to bring all the material up to date.

The secretariat will send out the draft chapters before the Work Session, so that an updated version could be considered at the meeting. Participants are asked to review the draft from two aspects:

- the text in general, to see whether the recommendations are still valid, identify new issues that might have emerged, make proposals and recommendations for improving the wording, structure, layout, etc.;
- check and update the examples relevant to their country.

4. Session B: Methods of Statistical Dissemination, Policies and Techniques

Contributions by Azerbaijan, Italy, Kyrgyzstan, Norway and USA.

This session will consider the relations of statistical offices and the media in the context of the overall dissemination policies of statistical offices and government media policies. It will look also at the international cooperation in dissemination, especially as targeted to the media.

5. Session C: Use of new audio-visual, electronic and print technologies in disseminating data to the media.

Contributions by Czech Republic, Hungary, ILO, Italy, USA and Russian Federation.

The contributions under this agenda item will demonstrate new approaches and technologies that can be used in data dissemination. Particular attention will be paid to media as a special client with specific requirements for speed, clarity, user-friendliness, etc. Internet is a medium which importance as a statistical data dissemination channel has increased considerably over the last years. Experience with statistical websites from countries will be presented.

6. Future work

Under this agenda item, the Work Session is expected to discuss issues of potential interest to countries for future work on the dissemination of statistical output to information media.


